# **Conjugate Skin**

## Skin in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>skin</b>	We <b>skin</b>
You <b>skin</b>	You <b>skin</b>
He/She/It <b>skins</b>	They <b>skin</b>

## **Skin in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am skinning	We <b>are skinning</b>
You <b>are skinning</b>	You <b>are skinning</b>
He/She/It is skinning	They are skinning

#### **Skin in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have skinned	We <b>have skinned</b>
You <b>have skinned</b>	You <b>have skinned</b>
He/She/It has skinned	They have skinned

### **Skin in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been skinning	We have been skinning
You <b>have been skinning</b>	You have been skinning
He/She/It has been skinning	They have been skinning

## Skin in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>skinned</b>	We <b>skinned</b>
You <b>skinned</b>	You <b>skinned</b>
He/She/It <b>skinned</b>	They <b>skinned</b>

## Skin in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was skinning	We <b>were skinning</b>
You <b>were skinning</b>	You <b>were skinning</b>
He/She/It was skinning	They were skinning

#### **Skin in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had skinned	We had skinned
You <b>had skinned</b>	You <b>had skinned</b>
He/She/It had skinned	They had skinned

### **Skin in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been skinning	We <b>had been skinning</b>
You <b>had been skinning</b>	You <b>had been skinning</b>
He/She/It had been skinning	They <b>had been skinning</b>

## Skin in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>will skin</b>	We will skin
You <b>will skin</b>	You <b>will skin</b>
He/She/It will skin	They <b>will skin</b>

## Skin in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be skinning	We <b>will be skinning</b>
You <b>will be skinning</b>	You <b>will be skinning</b>
He/She/It will be skinning	They will be skinning

### **Skin in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Skin in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been skinning	We <b>will have been skinning</b>
You <b>will have been skinning</b>	You <b>will have been skinning</b>
He/She/It will have been skinning	They will have been skinning
