<u>autumn</u>	The period from the autumn equinox to the winter solstice. <i>Europe can expect warmer summers and wetter</i> autumn s.
azalea	A deciduous flowering shrub with clusters of brightly coloured, sometimes fragrant flowers. Azaleas are typically smaller than other rhododendrons and there are numerous cultivars.
<u>backlash</u>	A strong negative reaction by a large number of people, especially to a social or political development. There was a backlash of intolerance.
<u>bloom</u>	Coat (a lens) with a special surface layer so as to reduce reflection from its surface. <i>The cherry tree</i> bloom <i>ed</i> .
boreal	Relating to or denoting the second climatic stage of the postglacial period in northern Europe between the Preboreal and Atlantic stages about 9 000 to 7 500 years ago marked by a warm dry climate. <i>Northern boreal forest.</i>
bounce	Hit something so that it bounces. The ball bounce d away and he chased it.
bungee	A long nylon cased rubber band used for securing luggage and in bungee jumping. <i>He bungeed 111 metres from the bridge over the Victoria Falls.</i>
<u>dance</u>	A social gathering at which people dance. Their cheeks were pressed together as they dance d.
efflorescent	Bursting into flower.
forth	From a particular thing or place or position forth is obsolete. Go forth and preach.
<u>frigid</u>	Extremely cold. A frigid greeting.



heating	Utility to warm a building. We had no heating in our bedrooms.
hop	A hopping movement. He hop ped down from the rock.
<u>hurdle</u>	Jump over a hurdle or other obstacle while running. <i>The last hurdle before graduation.</i>
icicle	Ice resembling a pendent spear, formed by the freezing of dripping water.
<u>jolt</u>	An abrupt spasmodic movement. The train jolt ed into motion.
jump	Cause to jump or leap. Every year hundreds of people jump off the Golden Gate bridge.
<u>leap</u>	Cause to jump or leap. Sales leap t by a third last year.
midwinter	The middle of winter. In midwinter the track became a muddy morass.
puissance	Power to influence or coerce. The puissance of the labor vote.
rap	A type of popular music of US black origin in which words are recited rapidly and rhythmically over an instrumental backing. <i>There was a confident</i> rap <i>at the door.</i>
<u>rebound</u>	The act of securing possession of the rebounding basketball after a missed shot. <i>His shot hammered into the post and rebounded across the goal.</i>
snowfall	A fall of snow. Heavy snowfall s made travel absolutely impossible.
spring	Move rapidly or suddenly from a constrained position by or as if by the action of a spring. <i>He might spring a few shillings more.</i>
summer	Spend the summer in a particular place. <i>Summer</i> holidays.
techno	A style of fast heavy electronic dance music usually without vocals.
vernal	Of, in, or appropriate to spring. The vernal freshness of the land.
walking	Close enough to be walked to. <i>Walking</i> is a healthy form of exercise.
<u>winter</u>	Keep or feed plants or cattle during winter. The tree has a good crop of berries in winter .
