# **Conjugate Slacken**

#### **Slacken in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>slacken</b>	We <b>slacken</b>
You <b>slacken</b>	You <b>slacken</b>
He/She/It <b>slackens</b>	They <b>slacken</b>

## **Slacken in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am slackening	We <b>are slackening</b>
You <b>are slackening</b>	You <b>are slackening</b>
He/She/It is slackening	They are slackening

#### **Slacken in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have slackened	We have slackened
You have slackened	You have slackened
He/She/It has slackened	They have slackened

## **Slacken in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been slackening	We have been slackening
You <b>have been slackening</b>	You have been slackening
He/She/It has been slackening	They have been slackening

## Slacken in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I slackened	We <b>slackened</b>
You <b>slackened</b>	You <b>slackened</b>
He/She/It <b>slackened</b>	They <b>slackened</b>

#### **Slacken in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was slackening	We were slackening
You <b>were slackening</b>	You were slackening
He/She/It was slackening	They were slackening

#### **Slacken in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had slackened	We had slackened
You had slackened	You had slackened
He/She/It had slackened	They had slackened

### **Slacken in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been slackening	We had been slackening
You <b>had been slackening</b>	You had been slackening
He/She/It had been slackening	They had been slackening

## **Slacken in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will slacken	We <b>will slacken</b>
You <b>will slacken</b>	You <b>will slacken</b>
He/She/It will slacken	They will slacken

## **Slacken in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be slackening	We will be slackening
You <b>will be slackening</b>	You <b>will be slackening</b>
He/She/It will be slackening	They will be slackening

#### **Slacken in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been slackening	We <b>will have been slackening</b>
You <b>will have been slackening</b>	You <b>will have been slackening</b>
He/She/It will have been slackening	They will have been slackening
