Associations of "Slammed" (30 Words)

bang	Leap jerk bang. <i>The shutter was banging in the wind.</i>
bat	Each of a pair of objects resembling table tennis bats used by a person on the ground to guide a taxiing aircraft. <i>Bat one s eyelids.</i>
bolt	Make or roll into bolts. <i>Bolt fabric.</i>
clap	Show approval of a person or action by clapping. <i>Louisa clapped his performance.</i>
crackle	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. <i>My Rice Krispies crackled in the bowl.</i>
dab	A brief application of a piece of absorbent material to a surface. <i>She dabbed at her eyes with a handkerchief.</i>
ding	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were dinging softly.</i>
door	A room that is entered via a door. <i>We closed the door to Haitian immigrants.</i>
gavel	Bring a hearing or person to order by use of a gavel. <i>He gavelled the convention to order.</i>
gouge	Make (a groove, hole, or indentation) with or as with a sharp tool or blade. <i>The channel had been gouged out by the ebbing water.</i>
hammering	The action or sound of hammering something. <i>A 7 0 hammering by the league leaders.</i>
knock	Knock against with force or violence. <i>He s younger than his brother knocking seventy.</i>
lick	A salt deposit that animals regularly lick. <i>Sammy gave his fingers a lick.</i>

lightning	A flash or discharge of lightning. <i>A tremendous flash of lightning.</i>
pat	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i>A pat of butter.</i>
ping	Hit with a pinging noise. <i>Victoria pinged the bell.</i>
punch	An iced mixed drink usually containing alcohol and prepared for multiple servings normally served in a punch bowl. <i>He punched me in the stomach.</i>
rap	Strike a hard surface with a series of rapid audible blows especially in order to attract attention. <i>Certain banks are to be rapped for delaying interest rate cuts.</i>
shut	Prevent from entering shut out. <i>Shut the window please.</i>
slap	Hit against or into something with the sound of something being slapped. <i>The parador is slap bang in the middle of the Alhambra.</i>
slash	Reduce (a price, quantity, etc.) greatly. <i>This year's sleeper hit is a faithful screen adaptation of Star Trek slash fiction.</i>
slayer	Someone who kills a person or animal in a violent way. <i>A dragon slayer.</i>
strike	A pitch that passes through the strike zone. <i>Strike action.</i>
swipe	Pass a swipe card through an electronic device designed to read and process the information encoded on it. <i>He missed the ball with his first swipe.</i>
tap	The act of tapping a telephone or telegraph line to get information. <i>The air supply tap.</i>
thrash	Give a thrashing to beat hard. <i>The system is thrashing again.</i>
thunder	Be the case that thunder is being heard. <i>You can hear the thunder of the falls in the distance.</i>
toss	Throw or toss with a light motion. <i>The toss of a coin.</i>
unlocked	Not firmly fastened or secured. <i>An opportunistic thief entered the property through an unlocked door.</i>
