## Associations of "Slammed" (30 Words)

<b>bang</b>	Leap jerk bang. <i>The shutter was <b>bang</b>ing in the wind.</i>
<b>bat</b>	Each of a pair of objects resembling table tennis bats used by a person on the ground to guide a taxiing aircraft. <i><b>Bat</b> one s eyelids.</i>
<b>bolt</b>	Make or roll into bolts. <i><b>Bolt</b> fabric.</i>
<b>clap</b>	Show approval of a person or action by clapping. <i>Louisa <b>clap</b>ped his performance.</i>
<b>crackle</b>	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. <i>My Rice Krispies <b>crack</b>led in the bowl.</i>
<b>dab</b>	A brief application of a piece of absorbent material to a surface. <i>She <b>dab</b>bed at her eyes with a handkerchief.</i>
<b>ding</b>	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were <b>ding</b>ing softly.</i>
<b>door</b>	A room that is entered via a door. <i>We closed the <b>door</b> to Haitian immigrants.</i>
<b>gavel</b>	Bring a hearing or person to order by use of a gavel. <i>He <b>gavel</b>led the convention to order.</i>
<b>gouge</b>	Make (a groove, hole, or indentation) with or as with a sharp tool or blade. <i>The channel had been <b>gouge</b>d out by the ebbing water.</i>
<b>hammering</b>	The action or sound of hammering something. <i>A 7 0 <b>hammer</b>ing by the league leaders.</i>
<b>knock</b>	Knock against with force or violence. <i>He s younger than his brother <b>knock</b>ing seventy.</i>
<b>lick</b>	A salt deposit that animals regularly lick. <i>Sammy gave his fingers a <b>lick</b>.</i>

<b>lightning</b>	A flash or discharge of lightning. <i>A tremendous flash of <b>lightning</b>.</i>
<b>pat</b>	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i>A <b>pat</b> of butter.</i>
<b>ping</b>	Hit with a pinging noise. <i>Victoria <b>pinged</b> the bell.</i>
<b>punch</b>	An iced mixed drink usually containing alcohol and prepared for multiple servings normally served in a punch bowl. <i>He <b>punched</b> me in the stomach.</i>
<b>rap</b>	Strike a hard surface with a series of rapid audible blows especially in order to attract attention. <i>Certain banks are to be <b>rapped</b> for delaying interest rate cuts.</i>
<b>shut</b>	Prevent from entering shut out. <i><b>Shut</b> the window please.</i>
<b>slap</b>	Hit against or into something with the sound of something being slapped. <i>The parador is <b>slap</b> bang in the middle of the Alhambra.</i>
<b>slash</b>	Reduce (a price, quantity, etc.) greatly. <i>This year's sleeper hit is a faithful screen adaptation of Star Trek <b>slash</b> fiction.</i>
<b>slayer</b>	Someone who kills a person or animal in a violent way. <i>A dragon <b>slayer</b>.</i>
<b>strike</b>	A pitch that passes through the strike zone. <i><b>Strike</b> action.</i>
<b>swipe</b>	Pass a swipe card through an electronic device designed to read and process the information encoded on it. <i>He missed the ball with his first <b>swipe</b>.</i>
<b>tap</b>	The act of tapping a telephone or telegraph line to get information. <i>The air supply <b>tap</b>.</i>
<b>thrash</b>	Give a thrashing to beat hard. <i>The system is <b>thrashing</b> again.</i>
<b>thunder</b>	Be the case that thunder is being heard. <i>You can hear the <b>thunder</b> of the falls in the distance.</i>
<b>toss</b>	Throw or toss with a light motion. <i>The <b>toss</b> of a coin.</i>
<b>unlocked</b>	Not firmly fastened or secured. <i>An opportunistic thief entered the property through an <b>unlocked</b> door.</i>
