## Associations of "Slamming" (30 Words)

<b>bang</b>	Leap jerk bang. <i>The window <b>banged</b> shut.</i>
<b>bat</b>	Use a bat. <i>A cricket <b>bat</b> has a narrow handle and a broad flat end for hitting.</i>
<b>bolt</b>	Secure or lock with a bolt. <i>New benefits have been <b>bolted</b> on to the social security system.</i>
<b>clap</b>	Clap one s hands or shout after performances to indicate approval. <i>There was no crescendo of applause just a lone volley of <b>claps</b>.</i>
<b>crackle</b>	Having the surface decorated with a network of fine cracks as in crackleware. <i>My Rice Krispies <b>crackled</b> in the bowl.</i>
<b>dab</b>	Hit lightly. <i>Apply concealer with light <b>dabs</b>.</i>
<b>ding</b>	Go ding dong like a bell. <i>Cash registers were <b>dinging</b> softly.</i>
<b>door</b>	A doorway. <i>That audition was the <b>door</b> to all my future successes.</i>
<b>gavel</b>	Bring a hearing or person to order by use of a gavel. <i>He <b>gavelled</b> the convention to order.</i>
<b>gouge</b>	Obtain by coercion or intimidation. <i>The channel had been <b>gouged</b> out by the ebbing water.</i>
<b>hammering</b>	The action or sound of hammering something. <i>A 7 0 <b>hammering</b> by the league leaders.</i>
<b>knock</b>	The sound of knocking as on a door or in an engine or bearing. <i>The <b>knocking</b> grew louder.</i>
<b>lick</b>	A salt deposit that animals regularly lick. <i>A tiny <b>lick</b> of flame <b>flickered</b> round the mouth of the flamethrower.</i>

<b>lightning</b>	A flash or discharge of lightning. <i>A tremendous flash of <b>lightning</b>.</i>
<b>pat</b>	Pat or squeeze fondly or playfully especially under the chin. <i>She <b>patted</b> down the earth in each pot.</i>
<b>ping</b>	Hit with a pinging noise. <i>The doorbell <b>pinged</b>.</i>
<b>punch</b>	Drive forcibly as if by a punch. <i>He <b>punched</b> her in the face and ran off.</i>
<b>rap</b>	Strike a hard surface with a series of rapid audible blows especially in order to attract attention. <i>We could be here all night <b>rapping</b> about spiritualism.</i>
<b>shut</b>	Move so that an opening or passage is obstructed make shut. <i>The door <b>shut</b> behind him.</i>
<b>slap</b>	Hit against or into something with the sound of something being slapped. <i>The parador is <b>slap</b> bang in the middle of the Alhambra.</i>
<b>slash</b>	Cut with a wide, sweeping movement, typically using a knife or sword. <i>This year s sleeper hit is a faithful screen adaptation of Star Trek <b>slash</b> fiction.</i>
<b>slayer</b>	Someone who kills a person or animal in a violent way. <i>A dragon <b>slayer</b>.</i>
<b>strike</b>	Undertake strike action against an employer. <i><b>Strike</b> an arc.</i>
<b>swipe</b>	Pass a swipe card through an electronic device designed to read and process the information encoded on it. <i>Simply <b>swipe</b> a finger across the phone s display screen to switch to another program.</i>
<b>tap</b>	Draw liquor from a tap. <i>Glover <b>tapdances</b> better than anybody.</i>
<b>thrash</b>	A violent or noisy movement of beating or thrashing. <i>Two months of <b>thrashing</b> around on my own have produced nothing.</i>
<b>thunder</b>	Thunder sounds. <i>You can hear the <b>thunder</b> of the falls in the distance.</i>
<b>toss</b>	Throw or toss with a light motion. <i><b>Toss</b> the pasta in the sauce.</i>
<b>unlocked</b>	Not locked. <i>An opportunistic thief entered the property through an <b>unlocked</b> door.</i>
