# **Conjugate Sleet**

## Sleet in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I sleet	We <b>sleet</b>
You <b>sleet</b>	You <b>sleet</b>
He/She/It <b>sleets</b>	They sleet

## **Sleet in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am sleeting	We are sleeting
You <b>are sleeting</b>	You are sleeting
He/She/It is sleeting	They are sleeting

#### **Sleet in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have sleeted	We have sleeted
You have sleeted	You have sleeted
He/She/It has sleeted	They have sleeted

### **Sleet in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been sleeting	We have been sleeting
You <b>have been sleeting</b>	You have been sleeting
He/She/It has been sleeting	They have been sleeting

## Sleet in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I sleeted	We <b>sleeted</b>
You <b>sleeted</b>	You <b>sleeted</b>
He/She/It <b>sleeted</b>	They $\boldsymbol{sleeted}$

#### **Sleet in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was sleeting	We were sleeting
You were sleeting	You were sleeting
He/She/It was sleeting	They were sleeting

#### **Sleet in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had sleeted	We had sleeted
You had sleeted	You <b>had sleeted</b>
He/She/It had sleeted	They had sleeted

## **Sleet in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been sleeting	We had been sleeting
You had been sleeting	You had been sleeting
He/She/It had been sleeting	They had been sleeting

## **Sleet in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will sleet	We <b>will sleet</b>
You <b>will sleet</b>	You <b>will sleet</b>
He/She/It will sleet	They will sleet

## **Sleet in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be sleeting	We will be sleeting
You will be sleeting	You will be sleeting
He/She/It will be sleeting	They will be sleeting

#### **Sleet in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Sleet in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been sleeting	We <b>will have been sleeting</b>
You <b>will have been sleeting</b>	You <b>will have been sleeting</b>
He/She/It will have been sleeting	They will have been sleeting
