sleuthhound A detective who follows a trail.






Usage Examples of "Sleuth" as a noun

• They make MI5 look like a bunch of amateur sleuths.






Sleuth as a Verb

Definitions of "Sleuth" as a verb

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "sleuth" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Watch, observe, or inquire secretly.
- Carry out a careful investigation into a crime or mystery.
- Discover by careful investigation.

Synonyms of "Sleuth" as a verb (3 Words)

snoop Watch, observe, or inquire secretly.
Your sister might find the ring if she goes snooping about.

Work for a government or other organization by secretly obtaining information


about enemies or competitors. **spy**

He would go and **spy** out the land.

Buy (shares in a new issue) and sell them at once for a profit.

I **stag**ged them off and burned the ends then tucked them away.
