## Associations of "Sliding" (30 Words)

<b>additive</b>	A substance added to something in small quantities to improve or preserve it. <i>An <b>additive</b> process.</i>
<b>blunder</b>	Commit a faux pas or a fault or make a serious mistake. <i>We were <b>blundering</b> around in the darkness.</i>
<a href="#">curve</a>	A pitch of a baseball that is thrown with spin so that its path curves as it approaches the batter. <i>The vehicle rounded a <b>curve</b>.</i>
<b>friction</b>	The resistance that one surface or object encounters when moving over another. <i>The <b>friction</b> of braking.</i>
<a href="#">glass</a>	Cover or enclose with glass. <i><b>Glass</b> in a porch.</i>
<a href="#">glide</a>	The activity of flying a glider. <i>Slide your hands firmly across the shoulders then <b>glide</b> them down.</i>
<b>ice</b>	An ice cream ice lolly or portion of water ice. <i>An <b>iced</b> summer drink.</i>
<b>inadvertence</b>	An unintentional omission resulting from failure to notice something.
<b>lapse</b>	(of a right, privilege, or agreement) become invalid because it is not used, claimed, or renewed; expire. <i>If your diet has <b>lapsed</b> it s time you revived it.</i>
<b>lubricant</b>	A substance used for lubricating an engine or component, such as oil or grease. <i>The pipe ends had been smeared with <b>lubricant</b>.</i>
<b>lubricity</b>	Feeling morbid sexual desire or a propensity to lewdness.
<b>oil</b>	Administer an oil or ointment to often in a religious ceremony of blessing. <i><b>Oil</b> the wooden surface.</i>

<b>oversight</b>	An unintentional omission resulting from failure to notice something. <i>Was the mistake due to <b>oversight</b>.</i>
<b>skid</b>	Cause to skid. <i>They <b>skidded</b> the logs down the hill to the waterfront.</i>
<b>sledge</b>	Travel or slide downhill over snow on a sledge. <i>They <b>sledged</b> down the slopes in the frozen snow.</i>
<b><u>slick</u></b>	An oil slick. <i>His damp hair was <b>slicked</b> back.</i>
<b><u>slide</u></b>	A structure with a smooth sloping surface for children to slide down. <i>His <b>slide</b> didn't stop until the bottom of the hill.</i>
<b><u>slimy</u></b>	Repellently smooth and obsequious. <i>Thick <b>slimy</b> mud.</i>
<b>slip</b>	A slippery smoothness. <i>Sarah <b>slipped</b> into a red jacket.</i>
<b>slippery</b>	Not to be trusted. <i>How extraordinarily <b>slippery</b> a liar the camera is.</i>
<b><u>slither</u></b>	A slithering movement. <i>I spied a baby adder <b>slithering</b> away.</i>
<b><u>smooth</u></b>	Without breaks between notes smooth and connected. <i>A lovely <b>smooth</b> very fruity wine.</i>
<b>smoothly</b>	In a smooth way. <i>The bust is <b>smoothly</b> carved in white marble.</i>
<b>snake</b>	Move or extend with the twisting motion of a snake. <i>The <b>snake</b> did not have any provision for strong currency nations to help the weak.</i>
<b>snow</b>	A layer of snowflakes white crystals of frozen water covering the ground. <i>They would <b>snow</b> the public into believing that all was well.</i>
<b>soft</b>	In a relaxed manner or without hardship soft is nonstandard. <i>He was too <b>soft</b> for the army.</i>
<b>texture</b>	Give something a rough or uneven texture. <i>The <b>texture</b> of Neapolitan life.</i>
<b>toboggan</b>	Move along on a luge or toboggan. <i>We <b>tobogganed</b> down a steep hill nearby.</i>
<b>translucent</b>	(of a substance) allowing light, but not detailed shapes, to pass through; semi-transparent. <i>Her beautiful <b>translucent</b> skin.</i>

**vehicle**

A privately controlled company through which an individual or organization conducts a particular kind of business, especially investment.
