Definitions of "Slightly" as an adverb

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "slightly" as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- (with reference to a person's build) in a slender way.
- In a slim or slender manner.
- To a small degree; not considerably.
- To a small degree or extent.





Synonyms of "Slightly" as an adverb (11 Words)

a little	Not much.
faintly	To a faint degree or weakly perceived. <i>She smiled faintly.</i>
moderately	To a moderately sufficient extent or degree. Growth continues moderately .
more or less	Used to form the comparative of some adjectives and adverbs.
obscurely	In an obscure manner.
<u>rather</u>	More readily or willingly. I rather think he wants me to marry him.
slenderly	In a slim or slender manner. A slenderly built woman.
slimly	In a slim or slender manner.
<u>somewhat</u>	To certain extent or degree. A somewhat thicker book.

to some degree Imprecise but fairly close to correct.



vaguely Slightly. *He vaguely* remembered talking to her once.



Usage Examples of "Slightly" as an adverb

- Slightly built.
- The children argued because one slice of cake was slightly larger than the other.
- A slightly built girl.
- They are all slightly different.
- *He lowered his voice slightly.*





Associations of "Slightly" (30 Words)

Of an opinion or appraisal well founded justifiable. <i>Fighting for a just cause.</i>
Used in names of very small animals and plants e g least shrew. <i>He has the least talent of anyone.</i>



<u>less</u>	Lower in quality. <i>Less</i> time to spend with the family.
little	Informal small and of little importance. My dear little mother.
marginally	In a marginal manner. He s marginally worse than he was.
<u>mere</u>	Being nothing more than specified. A mere child.
mini	Denoting a miniature version of something. A leather mini .
<u>minimal</u>	The least possible. The aircraft suffered minimal damage.
<u>minimum</u>	The least possible. They checked visas with the minimum of fuss.
<u>minor</u>	Of a key or mode based on a minor scale and tending to produce a sad or pensive effect. A bid of two no trumps shows strength in the minor s.
<u>moderately</u>	To a moderately sufficient extent or degree. <i>Growth continues moderately.</i>
<u>partially</u>	In part; in some degree; not wholly. A partially open door.
partly	In part; in some degree; not wholly. The result is partly a matter of skill and partly of chance.
pinprick	Small puncture (as if made by a pin. <i>Compared with the indignities he had so far endured this was a mere</i> pinprick .
preferably	Ideally; if possible. He would like a place of his own preferably outside the town.
<u>rather</u>	More precisely. The knife is rather dull.
reasonably	By sensible standards of judgement; justifiably. <i>Acted quite reasonably.</i>
slight	Pay no attention to, disrespect. The chance of success is very slight .
smattering	A small amount of something. A smattering of snow.



<u>some</u>	To some extent quite a lot. That was some party.
<u>somewhat</u>	To a moderately sufficient extent or degree. <i>Matters have improved</i> somewhat since then.
soupcon	A slight but appreciable amount.
tapered	Becoming gradually narrower. Trousers with tapered legs.
trifling	Not worth considering. A trifling sum.
undersized	Of less than the usual size. The undersized cubs may not survive the winter.
