Synonyms of "Slime" as a noun (10 Words)

- goo** Any thick, viscous matter.
*He tipped the grayish **goo** from the test tube.*
- goop** Mawkish sentiment.
- guck** Any thick, viscous matter.
*He got mud and cow **guck** all over his white jersey.*
- gunk** Any thick, viscous matter.
*Factories spewing out unspeakable **gunk**.*
- mire** Deep soft mud in water or slush.
*Acres of land had been reduced to a **mire**.*

muck Any thick, viscous matter.
*Why do you let her read this **muck**.*

mud Information or allegations regarded as damaging or scandalous.
*Ankle deep in **mud** we squelched across a meadow.*

ooze The process of seeping.
*I picked a fruit and watched the **ooze** of fig milk from the stem.*

sludge An unattractive muddy shade of brown or green.
*Miscellaneous chemicals and treated **sludges**.*



Usage Examples of "Slime" as a noun

- *The cold stone was wet with slime.*
