Slow in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural
I am slowing We are slowing
You are slowing You are slowing
He/She/It is slowing They are slowing

Slow in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural
I have slowed We have slowed
You have slowed You have slowed
He/She/It has slowed They have slowed

Slow in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been slowing We have been slowing

You have been slowing You have been slowing

He/She/It has been slowing They have been slowing

Slow in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Slow in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was slowing We were slowing
You were slowing You were slowing
He/She/It was slowing They were slowing

Slow in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had slowed
You had slowed
He/She/It had slowed
They had slowed

Slow in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been slowing
You had been slowing
He/She/It had been slowing
They had been slowing

Slow in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I will slow We will slow
You will slow You will slow
He/She/It will slow They will slow

Slow in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be slowing
You will be slowing
He/She/It will be slowing
They will be slowing

Slow in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have slowed
You will have slowed
He/She/It will have slowed
They will have slowed

Slow in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been slowing
You will have been slowing
He/She/It will have been slowing
They will have been slowing
