Infinitive	to slow-walk
Present Tense	slow-walk / slow-walks
Past Tense	slow-walked
Present Participle	slow-walking
Past Participle	slow-walked

# **Conjugate Slow-walk**

## Slow-walk in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I slow-walk	We <b>slow-walk</b>
You <b>slow-walk</b>	You <b>slow-walk</b>
He/She/It <b>slow-walks</b>	They <b>slow-walk</b>

## **Slow-walk in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am slow-walking	We are slow-walking
You <b>are slow-walking</b>	You are slow-walking
He/She/It is slow-walking	They are slow-walking

## **Slow-walk in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have slow-walked	We have slow-walked
You have slow-walked	You have slow-walked
He/She/It has slow-walked	They have slow-walked

## **Slow-walk in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been slow-walking	We <b>have been slow-walking</b>
You <b>have been slow-walking</b>	You have been slow-walking
He/She/It has been slow-walking	They have been slow-walking

## Slow-walk in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I slow-walked	We <b>slow-walked</b>
You <b>slow-walked</b>	You <b>slow-walked</b>
He/She/It <b>slow-walked</b>	They <b>slow-walked</b>

#### **Slow-walk in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was slow-walking	We were slow-walking
You <b>were slow-walking</b>	You were slow-walking
He/She/It was slow-walking	They were slow-walking

## **Slow-walk in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had slow-walked	We had slow-walked
You had slow-walked	You had slow-walked
He/She/It had slow-walked	They had slow-walked

## **Slow-walk in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been slow-walking	We had been slow-walking
You <b>had been slow-walking</b>	You <b>had been slow-walking</b>
He/She/It had been slow-walking	They had been slow-walking

## Slow-walk in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will slow-walk	We <b>will slow-walk</b>
You <b>will slow-walk</b>	You <b>will slow-walk</b>
He/She/It will slow-walk	They will slow-walk

## Slow-walk in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be slow-walking	We will be slow-walking
You <b>will be slow-walking</b>	You <b>will be slow-walking</b>
He/She/It will be slow-walking	They will be slow-walking

## **Slow-walk in Future Perfect Tense**



SingularPluralI will have slow-walkedWe will have slow-walkedYou will have slow-walkedYou will have slow-walkedHe/She/It will have slow-walkedThey will have slow-walked

#### **Slow-walk in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been slow-walking	We will have been slow-walking
You <b>will have been slow-walking</b>	You <b>will have been slow-walking</b>
He/She/It will have been slow-walking	They will have been slow-walking
