Statements which although literally true are **nevertheless** misleading.

In spite of that; nevertheless.

notwithstanding Nevertheless; in spite of this.

I didn't like it. **Notwithstanding**, I remained calm.

obvious Predictable and lacking in subtlety.

Obvious errors.

obviouslyUnmistakably (`plain' is often used informally for `plainly.

Used as intensifiers real is sometimes used informally for really rattling
