funky

Modern and stylish in an unconventional or striking way.

She likes funky clothes.

ill-scented Offensively malodorous.

malodorous Smelling very unpleasant.

Leaking taps and malodorous drains.



noisome Having an extremely offensive smell.

Noisome vapours from the smouldering waste.

noxious Harmful, poisonous, or very unpleasant.

Noxious chemical wastes.

pungent Strong and sharp.

The **pungent** taste of radishes.

putridOf or characteristic of rotting matter.

The **putrid** smells from the slaughterhouses.

rank Conspicuously and outrageously bad or reprehensible.

Rank treachery.

reeking

Wet with secreted or exuded moisture such as sweat or tears.

Wiped his **reeking** neck.

stinking Offensively malodorous.

He was locked in a **stinking** cell.

stinking to high heaven Offensively malodorous.
