stricken Grievously affected especially by disease.
*She looked at Anne's **stricken** face contorted with worry.*

struck (used in combination) affected by something overwhelming.
*Awe **struck**.*

decorous	Characterized by propriety and dignity and good taste in manners and conduct. <i>The tete a tete was decorous in the extreme.</i>
delicate	A delicate fabric or garment. <i>His delicate ball playing skills.</i>
doting	Extremely and uncritically fond of someone; adoring. <i>Deceiving her preoccupied and doting husband with a young captain.</i>

<u>enamored</u>	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. <i>Narcissus was a beautiful Greek youth who became enamored of his own reflection.</i>
enchantingly	In a bewitching manner.
<u>fond</u>	Having a strong preference or liking for. <i>Hopelessly spoiled by a fond mother.</i>
<u>infatuated</u>	Marked by foolish or unreasoning fondness. <i>An infatuated teenager.</i>
lovely	Very beautiful or attractive. <i>Lovely views.</i>
loving	Feeling or showing love or great care. <i>The cargo was described in loving detail.</i>
mawkish	Having a faint sickly flavour. <i>A mawkish ode to parenthood.</i>
melodrama	The genre of melodrama. <i>What little is known of his early life is cloaked in melodrama.</i>
<u>obsess</u>	Be preoccupied with something. <i>He was obsessed with the idea of revenge.</i>
<u>rendezvous</u>	Meet at a rendezvous. <i>A lively West End restaurant rendezvous.</i>
<u>romantic</u>	A person with romantic beliefs or attitudes. <i>A romantic adventure.</i>
sentimentality	Falsely emotional in a maudlin way. <i>There are passages which verge on sentimentality.</i>
stun	Knock unconscious or into a dazed or semi-conscious state. <i>The news stunned her.</i>
surprise	Cause to be surprised. <i>She surprised the couple.</i>
<u>tender</u>	Make a tender of in legal settlements. <i>The pale tender skin of her forearm.</i>
<u>tryst</u>	Keep a private, romantic rendezvous with a lover. <i>A moonlight tryst.</i>
