grey Of a person having grey hair.

hazy Indistinct or hazy in outline.

It was a beautiful day but quite **hazy**.

Dark and gloomy, especially due to thick mist.

The **murky** silt of a muddy pond.

smoggy Clouded with a mixture of smoke and fog. The **smoggy** atmosphere of Los Angeles.

smoke-filled Containing smoke.

Used in names of birds and other animals that are mainly blackish or

sooty brownish black e g sooty tern.

His olive skin and **sooty** eyes.

Not thin of a specific thickness or of relatively great extent from one surface

thick to the opposite usually in the smallest of the three solid dimensions.

Thick coating of dust.
