- *A collection containing a variety of sorts of things.*
- *An assortment of foods starting with herring or smoked eel or salmon etc with bread and butter; then cheeses and eggs and pickled vegetables and aspics; finally hot foods; served as a buffet meal.*
- *A range of open sandwiches and delicacies served as hors d'oeuvres or a buffet.*
- *A wide range of something; a variety.*



## Synonyms of "Smorgasbord" as a noun (21 Words)

<b>assemblage</b>	A system of components assembled together for a particular purpose. <i>A loose <b>assemblage</b> of diverse groups.</i>
<b>assortment</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>The room was filled with an <b>assortment</b> of clothes.</i>
<b>blend</b>	The act of blending components together thoroughly. <i>Nearly all Scotch whiskies are <b>blends</b>.</i>
<b>cold meal</b>	The absence of heat.
<b>cold table</b>	A mild viral infection involving the nose and respiratory passages (but not the lungs).
<b>collection</b>	A sum of money raised during a church or charity collection. <i>A preview of their autumn <b>collection</b>.</i>
<b>medley</b>	A varied mixture of people or things. <i>An interesting <b>medley</b> of flavours.</i>

<b>melange</b>	A motley assortment of things. <i>A <b>melange</b> of tender vegetables and herbs.</i>
<b>miscellanea</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i><b>Miscellanea</b> derived from a job lot of anthropological monographs.</i>
<b>miscellany</b>	A group or collection of different items; a mixture. <i>A <b>miscellany</b> of houses.</i>
<b>mix</b>	A commercially prepared mixture of dry ingredients. <i>A group of young women groove in a circle to a DJ <b>mix</b> of Missy Elliot the Young Gunz and Kelis.</i>
<b><u>mixture</u></b>	An event that combines things in a mixture. <i>He drank a <b>mixture</b> of beer and lemonade.</i>
<b>motley</b>	A garment made of motley especially a court jester s costume. <i>A <b>motley</b> of interacting interest groups.</i>
<b>motley collection</b>	A garment made of motley (especially a court jester’s costume.
<b>pastiche</b>	An artistic work in a style that imitates that of another work, artist, or period. <i>The songs amount to much more than blatant <b>pastiche</b>.</i>
<b>patchwork</b>	Sewing consisting of pieces of different materials sewn together in a pattern. <i>A piece of <b>patchwork</b>.</i>
<b>potpourri</b>	A musical composition consisting of a series of songs or other musical pieces from various sources. <i>He played a <b>potpourri</b> of tunes from Gilbert and Sullivan.</i>
<b>salmagundi</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>It is a <b>salmagundi</b> of styles.</i>
<b>selection</b>	A plot of land acquired by selection. <i>Such men decided the <b>selection</b> of candidates.</i>
<b>self-service</b>	The practice of serving yourself (as in a grocery or cafeteria.
<b>variety</b>	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>A <b>variety</b> show.</i>
