# **Conjugate Snag**

### **Snag in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>snag</b>	We <b>snag</b>
You <b>snag</b>	You <b>snag</b>
He/She/It <b>snags</b>	They <b>snag</b>

#### **Snag in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am snagging	We are snagging
You <b>are snagging</b>	You <b>are snagging</b>
He/She/It is snagging	They <b>are snagging</b>

#### **Snag in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have snagged	We have snagged
You <b>have snagged</b>	You have snagged
He/She/It has snagged	They have snagged

#### **Snag in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been snagging	We have been snagging
You <b>have been snagging</b>	You have been snagging
He/She/It has been snagging	They have been snagging

#### **Snag in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>snagged</b>	We <b>snagged</b>
You <b>snagged</b>	You <b>snagged</b>
He/She/It <b>snagged</b>	They <b>snagged</b>

#### **Snag in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was snagging	We <b>were snagging</b>
You <b>were snagging</b>	You were snagging
He/She/It was snagging	They were snagging

#### **Snag in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had snagged	We had snagged
You <b>had snagged</b>	You <b>had snagged</b>
He/She/It had snagged	They had snagged

#### **Snag in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been snagging	We had been snagging
You <b>had been snagging</b>	You had been snagging
He/She/It had been snagging	They had been snagging

## **Snag in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will snag</b>	We <b>will snag</b>
You <b>will snag</b>	You <b>will snag</b>
He/She/It will snag	They will snag

### **Snag in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be snagging	We will be snagging
You <b>will be snagging</b>	You <b>will be snagging</b>
He/She/It will be snagging	They will be snagging

#### **Snag in Future Perfect Tense**

#### **Snag in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been snagging	We <b>will have been snagging</b>
You <b>will have been snagging</b>	You <b>will have been snagging</b>
He/She/It will have been snagging	They will have been snagging
