## The Forms of Snape

Infinitive	<b>to snape</b>
Present Tense	<b>snape / snapes</b>
Past Tense	<b>snaped</b>
Present Participle	<b>snaping</b>
Past Participle	<b>snaped</b>

## Conjugate Snape

### Snape in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>snape</b>	We <b>snape</b>
You <b>snape</b>	You <b>snape</b>
He/She/It <b>snapes</b>	They <b>snape</b>

## **Snape in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am snapping</b>	We <b>are snapping</b>
You <b>are snapping</b>	You <b>are snapping</b>
He/She/It <b>is snapping</b>	They <b>are snapping</b>

## **Snape in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have snapped</b>	We <b>have snapped</b>
You <b>have snapped</b>	You <b>have snapped</b>
He/She/It <b>has snapped</b>	They <b>have snapped</b>

## **Snape in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been snapping</b>	We <b>have been snapping</b>
You <b>have been snapping</b>	You <b>have been snapping</b>
He/She/It <b>has been snapping</b>	They <b>have been snapping</b>

I <b>snaped</b>	We <b>snaped</b>
You <b>snaped</b>	You <b>snaped</b>
He/She/It <b>snaped</b>	They <b>snaped</b>

I <b>was snapping</b>	We <b>were snapping</b>
You <b>were snapping</b>	You <b>were snapping</b>
He/She/It <b>was snapping</b>	They <b>were snapping</b>

I <b>had snaped</b>	We <b>had snaped</b>
You <b>had snaped</b>	You <b>had snaped</b>
He/She/It <b>had snaped</b>	They <b>had snaped</b>

**Snape in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I <b>had been snapping</b>	We <b>had been snapping</b>
You <b>had been snapping</b>	You <b>had been snapping</b>
He/She/It <b>had been snapping</b>	They <b>had been snapping</b>

**Snape in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I <b>will snape</b>	We <b>will snape</b>
You <b>will snape</b>	You <b>will snape</b>
He/She/It <b>will snape</b>	They <b>will snape</b>

I <b>will be snapping</b>	We <b>will be snapping</b>
You <b>will be snapping</b>	You <b>will be snapping</b>
He/She/It <b>will be snapping</b>	They <b>will be snapping</b>

**Snape in Future Perfect Tense**

**I will have snaped**

**We will have snaped**

**You will have snaped**

**You will have snaped**

**He/She/It will have snaped**

**They will have snaped**

**Snap in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been snapping**

**We will have been snapping**

**You will have been snapping**

**You will have been snapping**

**He/She/It will have been snapping**

**They will have been snapping**
