## Snarky as an Adjective

### Definitions of "Snarky" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “snarky” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Bad-tempered or irritable.*
- *Critical or mocking in an indirect or sarcastic way.*
- *Disdainfully or ironically humorous; scornful and mocking.*

### Synonyms of "Snarky" as an adjective (7 Words)

<b>acerbic</b>	Harsh or corrosive in tone. <i>His <b>acerbic</b> wit.</i>
<b>cutting</b>	Capable of cutting something. <i>A <b>cutting</b> wind.</i>
<b>sarcastic</b>	Marked by or given to using irony in order to mock or convey contempt. <i>Making <b>sarcastic</b> comments.</i>
<b>sardonic</b>	Grimly mocking or cynical. <i>Starkey attempted a <b>sardonic</b> smile.</i>
<b>satirical</b>	Containing or using satire. <i>A persistent campaign of mockery by the <b>satirical</b> fortnightly magazine.</i>

**scathing** Marked by harshly abusive criticism.  
*His **scathing** remarks about silly lady novelists.*

**sharp** Having or emitting a high pitched and sharp tone or tones.  
*The job was a **sharp** contrast from her past life.*

### Usage Examples of "Snarky" as an adjective

- *Bobby's always a bit snarky before his nap.*
- *Snarky remarks.*
