- *Showing disapproval or contempt towards others, especially those considered to belong to a lower social class.*
- *Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage.*
- *(used colloquially) overly conceited or arrogant.*



Synonyms of "Snooty" as an adjective (17 Words)

- aloof** Not friendly or forthcoming; cool and distant.
*He stayed **aloof** from the bickering.*
- arrogant** Having or showing feelings of unwarranted importance out of overbearing pride.
*A typically **arrogant** assumption.*
- bigheaded** Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage.
- conceited** Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.
*An attitude of self **conceited** arrogance.*
- disdainful** Expressing extreme contempt.
*Some economists are **disdainful** of their colleagues in other social disciplines.*
- exclusive** Not including.
*Prices are **exclusive** of VAT.*

haughty	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i>Haughty aristocrats.</i>
lofty	Of imposing height. <i>Lofty intellectual disdain.</i>
persnickety	Requiring a particularly precise or careful approach. <i>It s hard to find a film more persnickety and difficult to use than black and white infrared.</i>
proud	Of an event achievement etc causing someone to feel proud. <i>A proud name.</i>
self-important	Having or showing feelings of unwarranted importance out of overbearing pride.
snot-nosed	Dirty with nasal discharge.
snotty	Having or showing a superior or conceited attitude. <i>A snotty letter.</i>
stuck-up	Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage.
supercilious	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i>Curled his lip in a supercilious smile.</i>
superior	Of high or superior quality or performance. <i>The new model is superior to every other car on the road.</i>
uppish	Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage. <i>She sensed that her accent made her sound uppish.</i>
