### Definitions of "Snooty" as an adjective

- *Showing disapproval or contempt towards others, especially those considered to belong to a lower social class.*
- *Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage.*
- *(used colloquially) overly conceited or arrogant.*



## Synonyms of "Snooty" as an adjective (17 Words)

- aloof** Not friendly or forthcoming; cool and distant.  
*He stayed **aloof** from the bickering.*
- arrogant** Having or showing feelings of unwarranted importance out of overbearing pride.  
*A typically **arrogant** assumption.*
- bigheaded** Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage.
- conceited** Characteristic of false pride; having an exaggerated sense of self-importance.  
*An attitude of self **conceited** arrogance.*
- disdainful** Expressing extreme contempt.  
*Some economists are **disdainful** of their colleagues in other social disciplines.*
- exclusive** Not including.  
*Prices are **exclusive** of VAT.*

<b>haughty</b>	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i><b>Haughty</b> aristocrats.</i>
<b>lofty</b>	Of imposing height. <i><b>Lofty</b> intellectual disdain.</i>
<b>persnickety</b>	Requiring a particularly precise or careful approach. <i>It s hard to find a film more <b>persnickety</b> and difficult to use than black and white infrared.</i>
<b>proud</b>	Of an event achievement etc causing someone to feel proud. <i>A <b>proud</b> name.</i>
<b>self-important</b>	Having or showing feelings of unwarranted importance out of overbearing pride.
<b>snot-nosed</b>	Dirty with nasal discharge.
<b>snotty</b>	Having or showing a superior or conceited attitude. <i>A <b>snotty</b> letter.</i>
<b>stuck-up</b>	Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage.
<b>supercilious</b>	Having or showing arrogant superiority to and disdain of those one views as unworthy. <i>Curled his lip in a <b>supercilious</b> smile.</i>
<b>superior</b>	Of high or superior quality or performance. <i>The new model is <b>superior</b> to every other car on the road.</i>
<b>uppish</b>	Overly conceited or arrogant-Laurent Le Sage. <i>She sensed that her accent made her sound <b>uppish</b>.</i>
