Snort as a Noun

Definitions of "Snort" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “snort” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A measure of an alcoholic drink.*
- *A quantity of an illegal drug, especially cocaine, inhaled in powdered form through the nose.*
- *A disrespectful laugh.*
- *An explosive sound made by the sudden forcing of breath through one's nose, used to express indignation, derision, or incredulity.*
- *A snorting sound made by an animal, typically when excited or frightened.*
- *A cry or noise made to express displeasure or contempt.*



Synonyms of "Snort" as a noun (10 Words)

- bird** The flesh of a bird or fowl wild or domestic used as food.
*She s a sharp old **bird**.*
- boo** An utterance of boo to show disapproval of a speaker or performer.
*The audience greeted this comment with **boos** and hisses.*
- bronx cheer** A cry or shout of approval.
- hiss** A cry or noise made to express displeasure or contempt.
*The spit and **hiss** of a cornered cat.*
- hoot** A short outburst of laughter.
*There were **hoots** of derision.*
- raspberry** The plant which yields the raspberry forming tall stiff prickly stems or canes.
*A **raspberry** tweed jacket.*

razz	A cry or noise made to express displeasure or contempt.
razzing	A cry or noise made to express displeasure or contempt.
snicker	A disrespectful laugh. <i>He could not evoke a snicker with his jokes.</i>
snigger	A half-suppressed, typically scornful laugh. <i>We heard the sniggers caused by their little jokes.</i>



Usage Examples of "Snort" as a noun

- *He gave a snort of disgust.*
- *They were high on a few snorts.*
- *She could hear the occasional snort of a pony.*
- *A bottle of rum was opened and they took a good long snort.*



Snort as a Verb

Definitions of "Snort" as a verb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), "snort" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- *Indicate contempt by breathing noisily and forcefully through the nose.*
- *Make a sudden explosive sound through one's nose, especially to express indignation or derision.*
- *Make a snorting sound by exhaling hard.*
- *(of an animal) make a sudden explosive sound through the nose, especially when excited or frightened.*
- *Inhale recreational drugs.*

- *Inhale (the powdered form of an illegal drug, especially cocaine) through the nose.*
- *Inhale through the nose.*



Synonyms of "Snort" as a verb (2 Words)

huff Blow hard and loudly.
*The kids were **huffing** glue.*

take a hit Pick out, select, or choose from a number of alternatives.



Usage Examples of "Snort" as a verb

- *The critic snorted contemptuously.*
- *She snorted with laughter.*
- *The addict was snorting cocaine almost every day.*
- *The horse came to a halt, snorting.*
- *She snorted her disapproval of the proposed bridegroom.*
- *'How perfectly ridiculous!' he snorted.*
- *Debbie had spent the evening snorting cocaine and drinking.*
