Snow-blow in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **snow-blow** We **snow-blow**
You **snow-blow** You **snow-blow**
He/She/It **snow-blows** They **snow-blow**

Snow-blow in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I **am snow-blowing** We **are snow-blowing**
You **are snow-blowing** You **are snow-blowing**
He/She/It **is snow-blowing** They **are snow-blowing**

Snow-blow in Present Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I **have snow-blown** We **have snow-blown**
You **have snow-blown** You **have snow-blown**
He/She/It **has snow-blown** They **have snow-blown**

Snow-blow in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

I **have been snow-blowing** We **have been snow-blowing**
You **have been snow-blowing** You **have been snow-blowing**
He/She/It **has been snow-blowing** They **have been snow-blowing**

I **snow-blown** We **snow-blown**
You **snow-blown** You **snow-blown**
He/She/It **snow-blown** They **snow-blown**

Snow-blow in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I was snow-blowing We were snow-blowing
You were snow-blowing You were snow-blowing
He/She/It was snow-blowing They were snow-blowing

Snow-blow in Past Perfect Tense

Singular

Plural

I had snow-blown We had snow-blown
You had snow-blown You had snow-blown
He/She/It had snow-blown They had snow-blown

Snow-blow in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular

Plural

I had been snow-blowing We had been snow-blowing
You had been snow-blowing You had been snow-blowing
He/She/It had been snow-blowing They had been snow-blowing

Snow-blow in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will snow-blow We will snow-blow
You will snow-blow You will snow-blow
He/She/It will snow-blow They will snow-blow

Snow-blow in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular

Plural

I will be snow-blowing We will be snow-blowing
You will be snow-blowing You will be snow-blowing
He/She/It will be snow-blowing They will be snow-blowing

I will have snow-blown

We will have snow-blown

You will have snow-blown

You will have snow-blown

He/She/It will have snow-blown They will have snow-blown

We will have been snow-blowing
