Present Tense	<b>snowboard / snowboards</b>
Past Tense	<b>snowboarded</b>
Present Participle	<b>snowboarding</b>
Past Participle	<b>snowboarded</b>

## Conjugate Snowboard

**Snowboard in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **snowboard**

We **snowboard**

You **snowboard**

You **snowboard**

He/She/It **snowboards** They **snowboard**

## **Snowboard in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am snowboarding**

We **are snowboarding**

You **are snowboarding**

You **are snowboarding**

He/She/It **is snowboarding** They **are snowboarding**

## **Snowboard in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have snowboarded**

We **have snowboarded**

You **have snowboarded**

You **have snowboarded**

He/She/It **has snowboarded** They **have snowboarded**

## **Snowboard in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have been snowboarding**

We **have been snowboarding**

You **have been snowboarding**

You **have been snowboarding**

He/She/It **has been snowboarding** They **have been snowboarding**

## **Snowboard in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **snowboarded**

We **snowboarded**

You **snowboarded**

You **snowboarded**

He/She/It **snowboarded** They **snowboarded**

## **Snowboard in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was snowboarding</b>	<b>We were snowboarding</b>
<b>You were snowboarding</b>	<b>You were snowboarding</b>
<b>He/She/It was snowboarding</b>	<b>They were snowboarding</b>

**Snowboard in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had snowboarded</b>	<b>We had snowboarded</b>
<b>You had snowboarded</b>	<b>You had snowboarded</b>
<b>He/She/It had snowboarded</b>	<b>They had snowboarded</b>

**Snowboard in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been snowboarding</b>	<b>We had been snowboarding</b>
<b>You had been snowboarding</b>	<b>You had been snowboarding</b>
<b>He/She/It had been snowboarding</b>	<b>They had been snowboarding</b>

**Snowboard in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will snowboard</b>	<b>We will snowboard</b>
<b>You will snowboard</b>	<b>You will snowboard</b>
<b>He/She/It will snowboard</b>	<b>They will snowboard</b>

**Snowboard in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be snowboarding</b>	<b>We will be snowboarding</b>
<b>You will be snowboarding</b>	<b>You will be snowboarding</b>
<b>He/She/It will be snowboarding</b>	<b>They will be snowboarding</b>

**Snowboard in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have snowboarded**

**We will have snowboarded**

**You will have snowboarded**

**You will have snowboarded**

**He/She/It will have snowboarded**

**They will have snowboarded**

**Snowboard in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been snowboarding**

**We will have been snowboarding**

**You will have been snowboarding**

**You will have been snowboarding**

**He/She/It will have been snowboarding**

**They will have been snowboarding**
