<u>length</u>	The length of a horse boat etc as a measure of the lead in a race. <i>He determined the <b>length</b> of the shortest line segment joining the two points.</i>
mile	A race extending over a mile. He rode the fastest <b>mile</b> of his entire career in 1914.
out-of-town	An urban area with a fixed boundary that is smaller than a city.
outback	The bush country of the interior of Australia. The <b>outback</b> of Ontario.
outlying	Relatively far from a center or middle. <i>Outlying</i> settlements.
outpost	A station in a remote or sparsely populated location. The community is the last <b>outpost</b> of civilization in the far north.
<u>remote</u>	A remote control device. Chances of a lasting peace became even more <b>remote</b> .
secluded	(of a place) not seen or visited by many people; sheltered and private. <i>A <b>secluded</b> romantic spot.</i>
<u>solitary</u>	Single; only. Tigers are essentially <b>solitary</b> .
<u>stray</u>	An animal that has strayed especially a domestic animal. <i>Stray capacitance.</i>
<u>then</u>	After that; next; afterwards. I was living in Cairo <b>then</b> .
