<b>detached</b>	Being or feeling set or kept apart from others. <i>She may be <b>detached</b> or even unfeeling but at least she s not hypocritically effusive.</i>
<a href="#"><u>distant</u></a>	Separate or apart in time. <i>A <b>distant</b> cousin of the King.</i>
<b>faraway</b>	Seeming remote from one’s immediate surroundings. <i>Exotic and <b>faraway</b> locations.</i>
<b>farther</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i><b>Farther</b> down the corridor.</i>
<b>forth</b>	From a particular thing or place or position forth is obsolete. <i>From that day <b>forth</b> he gave me endless friendship.</i>

<b>further</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i>Nothing could be <b>further</b> from the truth.</i>
<b>galaxy</b>	The galaxy of which the solar system is a part the Milky Way. <i>Extragalactic nebula is a former name for <b>galaxy</b>.</i>
<b>hence</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion hence adv from this place. <i>Get thee <b>hence</b>.</i>
<b>inaccessible</b>	Unable to be used. <i>A remote and <b>inaccessible</b> cave.</i>
<b>length</b>	The length of a horse boat etc as a measure of the lead in a race. <i>He determined the <b>length</b> of the shortest line segment joining the two points.</i>
<b>mile</b>	A race extending over a mile. <i>He rode the fastest <b>mile</b> of his entire career in 1914.</i>
<b>out-of-town</b>	An urban area with a fixed boundary that is smaller than a city.
<b>outback</b>	The bush country of the interior of Australia. <i>The <b>outback</b> of Ontario.</i>
<b>outlying</b>	Relatively far from a center or middle. <i><b>Outlying</b> settlements.</i>
<b>outpost</b>	A station in a remote or sparsely populated location. <i>The community is the last <b>outpost</b> of civilization in the far north.</i>
<b>remote</b>	A remote control device. <i>Chances of a lasting peace became even more <b>remote</b>.</i>
<b>secluded</b>	(of a place) not seen or visited by many people; sheltered and private. <i>A <b>secluded</b> romantic spot.</i>
<b>solitary</b>	Single; only. <i>Tigers are essentially <b>solitary</b>.</i>
<b>stray</b>	An animal that has strayed especially a domestic animal. <i><b>Stray</b> capacitance.</i>
<b>then</b>	After that; next; afterwards. <i>I was living in Cairo <b>then</b>.</i>
<b>therefore</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion therefore adv as a consequence. <i>He was injured and <b>therefore</b> unable to play.</i>
