out-of-town	An urban area with a fixed boundary that is smaller than a city.
outback	The bush country of the interior of Australia. The outback of Ontario.
outlying	Relatively far from a center or middle. <i>Outlying</i> settlements.
outpost	A station in a remote or sparsely populated location. The community is the last outpost of civilization in the far north.
<u>remote</u>	A remote control device. Chances of a lasting peace became even more remote .
secluded	(of a place) not seen or visited by many people; sheltered and private. <i>A secluded romantic spot.</i>
<u>solitary</u>	Single; only. Tigers are essentially solitary .
<u>stray</u>	An animal that has strayed especially a domestic animal. <i>Stray capacitance.</i>
