<a href="#">apart</a>	Remote and separate physically or socially- W.H.Hudson. <i>He leapt out of the car just before it was blown <b>apart</b>.</i>
<a href="#">consequently</a>	(sentence connectors) because of the reason given. <i><b>Consequently</b> he didn't do it.</i>
<a href="#">consistent</a>	Sometimes followed by with in agreement or consistent or reliable. <i>The injuries are <b>consistent</b> with falling from a great height.</i>
<a href="#">consistently</a>	In every case or on every occasion; invariably. <i>A team that <b>consistently</b> demonstrates a desire to win.</i>
<a href="#">continued</a>	Without a break in continuity; ongoing. <i>He asked for their <b>continued</b> support.</i>
<a href="#">detour</a>	Avoid by taking a detour. <i>He had made a <b>detour</b> to a cafe.</i>
<a href="#">elongate</a>	Long in relation to width elongated. <i>The pup's globular body slowly <b>elongates</b>.</i>
<a href="#">elongated</a>	Having notably more length than width; being long and slender. <i>The males are smaller and have more <b>elongated</b> bodies.</i>
<a href="#">endlessly</a>	Without bounds. <i>The original episodes were <b>endlessly</b> repeated.</i>
<a href="#">enduring</a>	Lasting over a period of time; durable. <i>He formed a number of <b>enduring</b> relationships with women.</i>
<a href="#">extend</a>	Continue or extend. <i>He really <b>extended</b> himself when he climbed Kilimanjaro.</i>
<a href="#">extended</a>	Fully extended or stretched forth. <i><b>Extended</b> farm lands.</i>
<a href="#">extensible</a>	Designed to allow the addition of new capabilities and functionality. <i>Silk is an exceptionally strong <b>extensible</b> and tough material.</i>

<b>farther</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i><b>Farther</b> north.</i>
<b>indefinitely</b>	To an unlimited or unspecified degree or extent. <i>Talks cannot go on <b>indefinitely</b>.</i>
<b>infinitely</b>	To a very great degree; immensely. <i>He is <b>infinitely</b> wealthy.</i>
<b>interminable</b>	Tiresomely long; seemingly without end. <i>We got bogged down in <b>interminable</b> discussions.</i>
<b>length</b>	The length of a horse boat etc as a measure of the lead in a race. <i>A <b>length</b> of brown satin.</i>
<b>lengthen</b>	Make (a vowel or syllable) long. <i>In the spring when the days are <b>lengthening</b>.</i>
<b>lengthy</b>	(especially in reference to time) of considerable or unusual length, especially so as to be tedious. <i>A <b>lengthy</b> visit from her mother in law.</i>
<b>outstretched</b>	Fully extended especially in length. <i>She reached across and shook his <b>outstretched</b> hand.</i>
<b>postpone</b>	Cause or arrange for (something) to take place at a time later than that first scheduled. <i>The visit had to be <b>postponed</b> for some time.</i>
<b>prolonged</b>	Continuing for a long time or longer than usual; lengthy. <i>A <b>prolonged</b> and bitter struggle.</i>
<b>protracted</b>	Relatively long in duration tediously protracted. <i>A <b>protracted</b> and bitter dispute.</i>
<b>really</b>	Used as intensifiers real is sometimes used informally for really rattling is informal. <i>A <b>really</b> enjoyable evening.</i>
<b>remarkably</b>	To a remarkable degree or extent. <i>He seems <b>remarkably</b> relaxed about the whole thing.</i>
<b>stretched</b>	Extended or spread over a wide area or distance. <i>Well <b>stretched</b> muscles are less susceptible to injury.</i>
<b>therefore</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion therefore adv as a consequence. <i><b>Therefore</b> X must be true.</i>
<b>thus</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion thus adv in the way indicated thusly is a nonstandard variant. <i>Set up the pieces <b>thus</b>.</i>
