<b>actually</b>	Used when expressing a contradictory or unexpected opinion or correcting someone. <i>She <b>actually</b> spoke Latin.</i>
<b>aforementioned</b>	Denoting a thing or person previously mentioned. <i>Works of all the <b>aforementioned</b> authors.</i>
<b>aforesaid</b>	Being the one previously mentioned or spoken of.
<b>candidly</b>	In an honest and straightforward way; frankly. <i>He <b>candidly</b> discussed his efforts to find employment.</i>
<b>certify</b>	Declare legally insane. <i>The Law Society will <b>certify</b> that the sum charged is fair and reasonable.</i>
<b><a href="#">chat</a></b>	Birds having a chattering call. <i>He dropped in for a <b>chat</b>.</i>
<b>chatter</b>	Make noise as if chattering away. <i>The starlings constant <b>chatter</b>.</i>
<b>dah</b>	The longer of the two telegraphic signals used in Morse code.
<b>describe</b>	Mark out or draw (a geometrical figure). <i>The man was <b>described</b> as tall clean shaven and with short dark hair.</i>
<b>dialog</b>	A conversation between two persons.
<b><a href="#">dialogue</a></b>	Provide a film or play with a dialogue. <i>The USA would enter into a direct <b>dialogue</b> with Vietnam.</i>
<b>explain</b>	Give a reason so as to justify or excuse (an action or event). <i>He <b>explained</b> the laws of physics to his students.</i>
<b>gibberish</b>	Unintelligible talking. <i>He talks <b>gibberish</b>.</i>
<b>hereby</b>	By means of this. <i>I <b>hereby</b> declare you man and wife.</i>

<b><u>honestly</u></b>	It is sincerely the case that used as intensives reflecting the speaker's attitude honestly adv in an honest manner. <i>She <b>honestly</b> believed that she was making life easier for Jack.</i>
<b>literally</b>	Used for emphasis while not being literally true. <i>Tiramisu <b>literally</b> translated pull me up.</i>
<b>mention</b>	An instance of being mentioned in dispatches. <i>I haven't <b>mentioned</b> it to William yet.</i>
<b><u>narrative</u></b>	The practice or art of telling stories. <i>Traditions of oral <b>narrative</b>.</i>
<b>palaver</b>	Have a lengthy discussion, usually between people of different backgrounds. <i>It's too hot for <b>palavering</b>.</i>
<b>prate</b>	Idle or foolish and irrelevant talk. <i>I heard him <b>prate</b> on for at least an hour and a half.</i>
<b>recitative</b>	Musical declamation of the kind usual in the narrative and dialogue parts of opera and oratorio, sung in the rhythm of ordinary speech with many words on the same note. <i>Singing in <b>recitative</b>.</i>
<b>speech</b>	(language) communication by word of mouth. <i>The actor forgot his <b>speech</b>.</i>
<b><u>spoken</u></b>	Speaking in a specified way. <i>Sharp <b>spoken</b>.</i>
<b>talk</b>	The act of giving a talk to an audience. <i>A <b>talk</b> on a day in the life of an actor.</i>
<b>talking</b>	The action of talking speech or discussion. <i>I'll do the <b>talking</b> you just back me up.</i>
<b>therefore</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion therefore adv as a consequence. <i>He was injured and <b>therefore</b> unable to play.</i>
<b><u>thus</u></b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion thus adv in the way indicated thusly is a nonstandard variant. <i>She rang up Susan and while she was <b>thus</b> engaged Chignell summoned the doctor.</i>
<b><u>truly</u></b>	By right. <i>He speaks <b>truly</b>.</i>
<b>verbosity</b>	The fact or quality of using more words than needed; wordiness. <i>A critic with a reputation for <b>verbosity</b>.</i>
