<b>dialogue</b>	Provide a film or play with a dialogue. <i>They disagreed but kept an open <b>dialogue</b>.</i>
<b>farther</b>	To or at a greater extent or degree or a more advanced stage further is used more often than farther in this abstract sense. <i>He is going no <b>farther</b> in his studies.</i>
<b>gibberish</b>	Unintelligible talking. <i>He talks <b>gibberish</b>.</i>
<b>hence</b>	From that fact or reason or as a result used to introduce a logical conclusion hence adv from this place. <i>The eggs were fresh and <b>hence</b> satisfactory.</i>
<b>hereby</b>	As a result of this document or utterance. <i>All such warranties are <b>hereby</b> excluded.</i>

<b>honestly</b>	It is sincerely the case that used as intensives reflecting the speaker's attitude honestly adv in an honest manner. <i><b>Honestly</b> that man is the absolute limit.</i>
<b>loquacious</b>	Tending to talk a great deal; talkative. <i>Never <b>loquacious</b> Sarah was now totally lost for words.</i>
<b>maunder</b>	Move or act in a dreamy or idle manner. <i>He <b>maunders</b> through the bank composing his thoughts.</i>
<b>narrative</b>	A spoken or written account of connected events; a story. <i>The coalition s carefully constructed <b>narrative</b> about its sensitivity to recession victims.</i>
<b>palaver</b>	Lengthy and unproductive discussion. <i>He <b>palavered</b> her into going along.</i>
<b>really</b>	Used as intensifiers real is sometimes used informally for really rattling is informal. <i>A <b>really</b> enjoyable evening.</i>
<b>recitative</b>	Musical declamation of the kind usual in the narrative and dialogue parts of opera and oratorio, sung in the rhythm of ordinary speech with many words on the same note. <i>Singing in <b>recitative</b>.</i>
<b>speech</b>	Something spoken. <i>He was born deaf and without the power of <b>speech</b>.</i>
<b>spoken</b>	Uttered through the medium of speech or characterized by speech; sometimes used in combination. <i>A <b>spoken</b> message.</i>
<b>talk</b>	Deliver a lecture or talk. <i>We were <b>talking</b> German.</i>
<b>talking</b>	The action of talking speech or discussion. <i>He did have <b>talking</b> eyes.</i>
<b>tell</b>	Mark as different. <i>He could <b>tell</b> that she was unhappy.</i>
<b>then</b>	Also; in addition. <i><b>Then</b> he left.</i>
<b>thereby</b>	By that means; as a result of that. <i>Students perform in hospitals <b>thereby</b> gaining a deeper awareness of the therapeutic power of music.</i>
