- civic** Relating to the duties or activities of people in relation to their town, city, or local area.
Civic duties.
- civil** Relating to civil law.
*A **civil** action.*
- collaborative** Accomplished by collaboration.
***Collaborative** research.*
- collective** Set up on the principle of collectivism or ownership and production by the workers involved usually under the supervision of a government.
*Ministers who share **collective** responsibility.*
- communal** Relating to a small administrative district or community.
*A **communal** bathroom and kitchen.*
- general** Prevailing among and common to the general public.
*A **general** introduction to the subject.*
- mass** Formed of separate units gathered into a mass or whole.
*The film has **mass** appeal.*
- public** Of or involved in the affairs of the community, especially in government or entertainment.
***Public** services.*

social Relating to or designed for activities in which people meet each other for pleasure.
*A purely **social** club.*
