<u>civic</u>	Relating to the duties or activities of people in relation to their town, city, or local area. <i>Civic duties.</i>
<u>civil</u>	Relating to civil law. A <i>civil</i> action.
collaborative	Accomplished by collaboration. <i>Collaborative</i> research.
<u>collective</u>	Set up on the principle of collectivism or ownership and production by the workers involved usually under the supervision of a government. <i>Ministers who share collective responsibility.</i>
<u>communal</u>	Relating to a small administrative district or community. A <b>communal</b> bathroom and kitchen.
<u>general</u>	Prevailing among and common to the general public. A <b>general</b> introduction to the subject.
<u>mass</u>	Formed of separate units gathered into a mass or whole. The film has <b>mass</b> appeal.
<u>public</u>	Of or involved in the affairs of the community, especially in government or entertainment. <i>Public services.</i>
