chaise longue A long chair; for reclining.

chesterfield A man's plain straight overcoat, typically with a velvet collar.

couch A reclining seat with a headrest at one end on which a psychoanalyst's subject or doctor's patient lies while undergoing treatment.

*I sat in an armchair and they sat on the **couch**.*

divan A long, low sofa without a back or arms.

knole sofa An upholstered seat for more than one person.

lounge An act or spell of lounging.

*A TV **lounge**.*

love seat A deep feeling of sexual desire and attraction.

settee A long wooden bench with a back.

| armchair | Lacking or not involving practical or direct experience of a particular subject or activity. <i>An armchair traveller.</i> |
| bed | Place plants in a prepared bed of soil. <i>The children were bedded at ten o'clock.</i> |
| bedspread | A decorative cloth used to cover a bed when it is not in use. |
| bookcase | An open cabinet containing shelves on which to keep books. |
| cafeteria | Denoting a system in which people may choose from a number of available options, especially one in which an employee may select a personal package of company benefits. <i>Employers who offer cafeteria plans and other flexible programs.</i> |
| <u>chair</u> | The post of a chairperson. <i>He was due to step down after a three year stint in the chair.</i> |

| closet | A small room, especially one used for storing things or for private study. <i>He returned home and closeted himself in his room.</i> |
| compartment | A partitioned section, chamber, or separate room within a larger enclosed area. <i>The buildings are to be compartmented by fire walls.</i> |
| couch | A narrow bed on which a patient lies during psychiatric or psychoanalytic treatment. <i>To arms cried Mortimer and couch d his quiv ring lance.</i> |
| cupboard | A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom cupboard.</i> |
| cushion | The layer of air supporting a hovercraft or similar vehicle. <i>The bag cushions equipment from inevitable knocks.</i> |
| desk | A piece of furniture with a flat or sloping surface and typically with drawers, at which one can read, write, or do other work. <i>An extra desk of first and second violins.</i> |
| desktop | The working area of a computer screen regarded as a representation of a notional desktop and containing icons representing items such as files. <i>A new low end desktop.</i> |
| drawer | A person who writes a cheque. <i>The banker would have rights as holder to pursue the drawer.</i> |
| freezer | Electric refrigerator (trade name Deepfreeze) in which food is frozen and stored for long periods of time. <i>The freezer compartment of the refrigerator.</i> |
| fridge | A refrigerator. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the fridge.</i> |
| furnishing | The instrumentalities (furniture and appliances and other movable accessories including curtains and rugs) that make a home (or other area) livable. <i>A large room filled with fine ornaments and luxurious furnishings.</i> |
| furniture | The small accessories or fittings that are required for a particular task or function. <i>There was only one piece of furniture in the room.</i> |
| kettle | The quantity a kettle will hold. <i>Activists in the kettle were protesting at being held and resisting arrest.</i> |
| kitchen | A set of fitments and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>A fully fitted kitchen at a bargain price.</i> |
| larder | A room or large cupboard for storing food. |

| <u>lounge</u> | Lie, sit, or stand in a relaxed or lazy way. <i>The hotel has a pleasant lounge and bar.</i> |
| pillow | Serve as a pillow for. <i>His head was pillowed on his arm.</i> |
| recline | Cause to recline. <i>He tried to recline his seat.</i> |
| recliner | An armchair whose back can be lowered and foot can be raised to allow the sitter to recline in it. |
| refrigerator | An appliance or compartment which is artificially kept cool and used to store food and drink Modern refrigerators generally make use of the cooling effect produced when a volatile liquid is forced to evaporate in a sealed system in which it can be condensed back to liquid outside the refrigerator. |
| <u>room</u> | The people who are present in a room. <i>I was rooming with my cousin.</i> |
| seat | Place in or on a seat. <i>Lampport Hall was the seat of the Isham family for over 400 years.</i> |
| stool | Lure with a stool as of wild fowl. <i>Concentrations of the substance in normal stool.</i> |
| <u>wardrobe</u> | Collection of clothing belonging to one person. <i>A wardrobe assistant.</i> |
