Associations of "Soldiers" (30 Words)

armor	Equip with armor.
army	The army of the United States of America the agency that organizes and trains soldiers for land warfare. <i>He joined the army at 16.</i>
bastion	A natural rock formation resembling a man made bastion. <i>A bastion against corruption.</i>
bomber	A bomber jacket. <i>Manny hand rolled a couple of bombers.</i>
brigade	Form into a brigade. <i>They thought the speech too closely brigaded with illegal action.</i>
cantonment	A permanent military station in British India.
castle	Move (the king) by castling. <i>The crumbling stonework of a ruined castle.</i>
centurion	The leader of 100 soldiers.
commander	A commissioned naval officer who ranks above a lieutenant commander and below a captain. <i>The commander of a paratroop regiment.</i>
defend	Be on the defensive; act against an attack. <i>They were forced to defend for long periods.</i>
defense	The team that is trying to prevent the other team from scoring. <i>Sanitation is the best defense against disease.</i>
fighting	The action of fighting violence or conflict. <i>He put up his fists and took a fighting stance.</i>
flotilla	A United States Navy fleet consisting of two or more squadrons of small warships. <i>A flotilla of cargo boats.</i>

<u>fort</u>	A fortified building or strategic position. <i>The city was guarded by a ring of forts.</i>
<u>fortress</u>	A fortified defensive structure. <i>He had proved himself to be a fortress of moral rectitude.</i>
<u>garrison</u>	The building occupied by a garrison. <i>Forces from these garrisons have been used against governments.</i>
<u>guardian</u>	A person who protects or defends something. <i>Self appointed guardians of public morality.</i>
<u>knight</u>	A chess piece typically with its top shaped like a horse's head that moves by jumping to the opposite corner of a rectangle two squares by three. Each player starts the game with two knights. <i>In all your quarrels I will be your knight.</i>
<u>legionary</u>	A soldier who is a member of a legion (especially the French Foreign Legion). <i>The legionary fortress of Isca.</i>
<u>military</u>	Characteristic of or associated with soldiers or the military. <i>The build up of military activity.</i>
<u>naval</u>	Relating to a navy or navies. <i>A naval officer.</i>
<u>outpost</u>	A military post stationed at a distance from the main body of troops. <i>The community is the last outpost of civilization in the far north.</i>
<u>protector</u>	A regent in charge of a kingdom during the minority, absence, or incapacity of the sovereign. <i>Ear protectors.</i>
<u>siege</u>	The action of an armed force that surrounds a fortified place and isolates it while continuing to attack. <i>Two cult members have died so far in the four day siege.</i>
<u>stockade</u>	Enclose an area by erecting a stockade. <i>We got ashore and into the stockade.</i>
<u>submarine</u>	Attack by submarine. <i>The Germans submarined the Allies.</i>
<u>territorial</u>	Displaying territoriality defending a territory from intruders. <i>These sharks are aggressively territorial.</i>
<u>warfare</u>	An active struggle between competing entities. <i>Diplomatic warfare.</i>
<u>warrior</u>	Any of a number of standing poses in yoga in which the legs are held apart and the arms are stretched outwards. <i>I really love the warrior pose it makes me feel centred and strong.</i>

warship A ship equipped with weapons and designed to take part in warfare at sea.
