Infinitive	<b>to solutionize</b>
Present Tense	<b>solutionize / solutionizes</b>
Past Tense	<b>solutionized</b>
Present Participle	<b>solutionizing</b>
Past Participle	<b>solutionized</b>

## **Conjugate Solutionize**

**Solutionize in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>solutionize</b>	We <b>solutionize</b>
You <b>solutionize</b>	You <b>solutionize</b>
He/She/It <b>solutionizes</b>	They <b>solutionize</b>

### **Solutionize in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am solutionizing</b>	We <b>are solutionizing</b>
You <b>are solutionizing</b>	You <b>are solutionizing</b>
He/She/It <b>is solutionizing</b>	They <b>are solutionizing</b>

### **Solutionize in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have solutionized</b>	We <b>have solutionized</b>
You <b>have solutionized</b>	You <b>have solutionized</b>
He/She/It <b>has solutionized</b>	They <b>have solutionized</b>

### **Solutionize in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been solutionizing</b>	We <b>have been solutionizing</b>
You <b>have been solutionizing</b>	You <b>have been solutionizing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been solutionizing</b>	They <b>have been solutionizing</b>

### **Solutionize in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>solutionized</b>	We <b>solutionized</b>
You <b>solutionized</b>	You <b>solutionized</b>
He/She/It <b>solutionized</b>	They <b>solutionized</b>

### **Solutionize in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was solutionizing      We were solutionizing  
You were solutionizing      You were solutionizing  
He/She/It was solutionizing      They were solutionizing

**Solutionize in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had solutionized      We had solutionized  
You had solutionized      You had solutionized  
He/She/It had solutionized      They had solutionized

**Solutionize in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been solutionizing      We had been solutionizing  
You had been solutionizing      You had been solutionizing  
He/She/It had been solutionizing      They had been solutionizing

**Solutionize in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will solutionize      We will solutionize  
You will solutionize      You will solutionize  
He/She/It will solutionize      They will solutionize

**Solutionize in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be solutionizing      We will be solutionizing  
You will be solutionizing      You will be solutionizing  
He/She/It will be solutionizing      They will be solutionizing

**Solutionize in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have solutionized**

**We will have solutionized**

**You will have solutionized**

**You will have solutionized**

**He/She/It will have solutionized**

**They will have solutionized**

**Solutionize in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**I will have been solutionizing**

**We will have been solutionizing**

**You will have been solutionizing**

**You will have been solutionizing**

**He/She/It will have been solutionizing**

**They will have been solutionizing**
