Somehow as an Adverb

Definitions of "Somehow" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “somehow” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *In some way; by some means.*
- *For some unspecified reason.*
- *For a reason that is not known or specified.*
- *In some unspecified way or manner; or by some unspecified means.*

Synonyms of "Somehow" as an adverb (10 Words)

by any means	In reserve; not for immediate use.
by any means whatsoever	In reserve; not for immediate use.
by fair means or foul	In reserve; not for immediate use.
by hook or by crook	So as to pass a given point.
by some means	In reserve; not for immediate use.
in one way or another	To or toward the inside of.
in some way	To or toward the inside of.

no matter how	Used to express refusal or denial or disagreement etc or especially to emphasize a negative statement.
someway	In some unspecified way or manner; or by some unspecified means. <i>We ve got to make money someway.</i>
someways	In some unspecified way or manner; or by some unspecified means.

Usage Examples of "Somehow" as an adverb

- *He looked different somehow.*
- *He expected somehow to discover a woman who would love him.*
- *Somehow I managed to get the job done.*
- *They managed somehow.*
