analyze	Consider in detail and subject to an analysis in order to discover essential features or meaning. <i>Analyze a chemical compound.</i>
assortment	A miscellaneous collection of things or people. <i>The room was filled with an assortment of clothes.</i>
categorize	Place in a particular class or group. <i>Children learn early on to categorize.</i>
classification	The basic cognitive process of arranging into classes or categories. <i>New classifications for drivers of commercial vehicles.</i>
classify	Arrange (a group of people or things) in classes or categories according to shared qualities or characteristics. <i>How would you classify these pottery shards are they prehistoric.</i>
different	Distinctly separate from the first. <i>Came to a different conclusion.</i>
dissimilar	Marked by dissimilarity. <i>Their understanding of the world is not so dissimilar from our own.</i>
distinguish	Be an identifying characteristic or mark of. <i>His modesty distinguishes him from his peers.</i>
diverse	Distinctly dissimilar or unlike. <i>Subjects as diverse as architecture language teaching and the physical sciences.</i>
diversity	The practice or quality of including or involving people from a range of different social and ethnic backgrounds and of different genders, sexual orientations, etc. <i>Equality and diversity should be supported for their own sake.</i>
hierarchical	Classified according to various criteria into successive levels or layers. <i>In her hierarchical set of values honesty comes first.</i>

identify	Give the name or identifying characteristics of refer to by name or some other identifying characteristic property. <i>3.2% of the men identified as gay or bisexual.</i>
miscellaneous	(of items or people gathered or considered together) of various types or from different sources. <i>Miscellaneous accessories.</i>
miscellany	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>A miscellany of houses.</i>
motley	Make motley color with different colors. <i>A jester dressed in motley.</i>
<u>multifaceted</u>	Having many different aspects or features. <i>A multifaceted undertaking.</i>
multifarious	Having many aspects. <i>A vast multifarious organization.</i>
multiplicity	A large number. <i>The demand for higher education depends on a multiplicity of factors.</i>
nomenclature	The body or system of names used in a particular specialist field. <i>Customers was preferred to the original nomenclature passengers.</i>
pastiche	Imitate the style of (an artist or work). <i>The songs amount to much more than blatant pastiche.</i>
pigeonhole	Put a document in a pigeonhole. <i>People identified me with a homely farmer s wife and I could never escape that pigeonhole.</i>
pluralism	A form of society in which the members of minority groups maintain their independent cultural traditions.
potpourri	A mixture of dried petals and spices placed in a bowl to perfume a room. <i>He played a potpourri of tunes from Gilbert and Sullivan.</i>
<u>sorting</u>	The basic cognitive process of arranging into classes or categories. <i>The bottleneck in mail delivery is the process of sorting.</i>
<u>stratified</u>	Formed or arranged into strata or layers. <i>Warming temperatures can lead to more stratified ocean layers.</i>
taxonomy	Study of the general principles of scientific classification. <i>The taxonomy of these fossils.</i>
type	Write something on a typewriter or computer by pressing the keys. <i>Small type is hard to read.</i>
variety	A collection containing a variety of sorts of things. <i>The range and variety of his work is amazing.</i>

various

Having or showing different properties or qualities.

vary

Make something more diverse and varied.
*He tried to **vary** his diet.*
