Definitions of "Soulful" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “soulful” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Expressing or appearing to express deep and often sorrowful feeling.*
- *Full of or expressing deep emotion.*



Synonyms of "Soulful" as an adjective (7 Words)

- deep** Relatively deep or strong affecting one deeply.
*A **deep** sigh.*
- emotional** Arousing or characterized by intense feeling.
*His behavior was highly **emotional**.*
- fervent** Extremely hot- Nathaniel Hawthorne- Frances Trollope.
*A **fervent** admirer.*
- heartfelt** Sincerely earnest.
***Heartfelt** condolences.*
- passionate** Having or expressing strong emotions.
*A **passionate** kiss.*
- profound** Coming from deep within one.
*A case of **profound** liver failure.*

sincere (of a person) saying what they genuinely feel or believe; not dishonest or hypocritical.
*He was a good man decent and **sincere**.*



Usage Examples of "Soulful" as an adjective

- *Soulful eyes.*
- *She gave him a soulful glance.*
- *Soulful music.*
