### ally

A state formally cooperating with another for a military or other purpose.

*He was forced to dismiss his closest political **ally**.*

### **associate**

A concept connected with another.

*First was the lightning and then its thunderous **associate**.*

### **best friend**

Canadian physiologist (born in the United States) who assisted F. G. Banting in research leading to the discovery of insulin (1899-1978).

**boon companion** A desirable state.

**bosom friend** A close affectionate and protective acceptance.

**classmate** A fellow member of a class at school, college, or university.

**close friend** The concluding part of any performance.

### companion

One paid to accompany or assist or live with another.

*A traveller s **companion**.*

<b><u>comrade</u></b>	Used as a term of address for those male persons engaged in the same movement. <i>You re right <b>comrade</b>.</i>
<b><u>confidant</u></b>	Someone to whom private matters are confided. <i>A close <b>confidante</b> of the princess.</i>
<b>confidante</b>	A female confidant.
<b><u>familiar</u></b>	A demon supposedly attending and obeying a witch, often said to assume the form of an animal. <i>Her <b>familiars</b> were her two little griffons that nested in her skirts.</i>
<b>intimate</b>	A very close friend. <i>His circle of <b>intimates</b>.</i>
<b>playfellow</b>	A companion at play. <i>They had been his boyhood <b>playfellows</b>.</i>
<b>playmate</b>	Used euphemistically to refer to a person's lover. <i>Her clients use this album of photos to pick their ideal <b>playmate</b>.</i>
<b>schoolmate</b>	An acquaintance that you go to school with. <i>I ran into an old <b>schoolmate</b> of mine.</i>
<b>second self</b>	An indefinitely short time.
<b><u>shadow</u></b>	A region of opacity on a radiograph. <i>A <b>shadow</b> over his happiness.</i>
<b>soul mate</b>	A human being.
<b>workmate</b>	A fellow worker.
