Soundtrack in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **soundtrack** We **soundtrack**You **soundtrack** You **soundtrack**He/She/It **soundtracks** They **soundtrack**

Soundtrack in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am soundtracking We are soundtracking
You are soundtracking You are soundtracking
He/She/It is soundtracking They are soundtracking

Soundtrack in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have soundtracked We have soundtracked You have soundtracked You have soundtracked He/She/It has soundtracked They have soundtracked

Soundtrack in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been soundtracking
You have been soundtracking
You have been soundtracking
He/She/It has been soundtracking
They have been soundtracking

Soundtrack in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **soundtracked** We **soundtracked**You **soundtracked** You **soundtracked**He/She/It **soundtracked** They **soundtracked**

Soundtrack in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was soundtracking We were soundtracking
You were soundtracking You were soundtracking
He/She/It was soundtracking They were soundtracking

Soundtrack in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had soundtracked We had soundtracked You had soundtracked He/She/It had soundtracked They had soundtracked

Soundtrack in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been soundtracking
You had been soundtracking
He/She/It had been soundtracking
They had been soundtracking

Soundtrack in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will soundtrack
You will soundtrack
He/She/It will soundtrack
They will soundtrack

Soundtrack in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be soundtracking
You will be soundtracking
He/She/It will be soundtracking
They will be soundtracking

Soundtrack in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have soundtracked
You will have soundtracked
You will have soundtracked
He/She/It will have soundtracked
They will have soundtracked

Soundtrack in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been soundtracking
You will have been soundtracking
He/She/It will have been soundtracking
They will have been soundtracking
