South in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I **south** We **south**
You **south** You **south**
He/She/It **souths** They **south**

South in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I **am southing** We **are southing**
You **are southing** You **are southing**
He/She/It **is southing** They **are southing**

South in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I **have southed** We **have southed**
You **have southed** You **have southed**
He/She/It **has southed** They **have southed**

South in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I **have been southing** We **have been southing**
You **have been southing** You **have been southing**
He/She/It **has been southing** They **have been southing**

South in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I **southed** We **southed**
You **southed** You **southed**
