### Definitions of "Souvenir" as a noun

- *Something of sentimental value.*
- *A thing that is kept as a reminder of a person, place, or event.*
- *A reminder of past events.*



## Synonyms of "Souvenir" as a noun (7 Words)

- keepsake**      Something of sentimental value.  
*She was wearing the medal he gave her as a **keepsake**.*
- memento**      A reminder of past events.  
*You can purchase a **memento** of your visit.*
- memorial**      A structure erected to commemorate persons or events.  
*The Council sent a strongly worded **memorial** to the Chancellor of the Exchequer.*
- relic**      A person or thing that has survived from an earlier time but is now outmoded.  
*Miracles wrought by the **relics** of St Stephen.*
- remembrance**      A recognition of meritorious service.  
*A flash of **remembrance** passed between them.*
- reminder**      A message that helps you remember something.  
*He ignored his wife s **reminders**.*

**token**

A voucher that can be exchanged for goods or services, typically one given as a gift or forming part of a promotional offer.

*Ruthven was murdered and the assassin left his **token**.*



**Usage Examples of "Souvenir" as a noun**

- *The recording provides a souvenir of a great production.*

<b>bus</b>	Send or move around by bus. <i>The fenders had fallen off that old <b>bus</b>.</i>
<b>coin</b>	Money in the form of coins. <i>He <b>coined</b> the term desktop publishing.</i>
<b>gear</b>	A particular setting of engaged gears. <i>Murray got him some <b>gear</b>.</i>
<b>item</b>	Used to introduce each item in a list. <i>An <b>item</b> of clothing.</i>
<b>keepsake</b>	Something of sentimental value. <i>She was wearing the medal he gave her as a <b>keepsake</b>.</i>
<b>kit</b>	Young of any of various fur-bearing animals. <i>An aircraft <b>kit</b>.</i>

<b>list</b>	A formal structure analogous to a list by which items of data can be stored or processed in a definite order. <i>I <b>listed</b> myself for a soldier.</i>
<b>listing</b>	An entry in a list or register.
<b>material</b>	Having material or physical form or substance. <i><b>Material</b> possessions.</i>
<b>matter</b>	A subject or situation under consideration. <i>Faecal <b>matter</b>.</i>
<b>memento</b>	A reminder of past events. <i>You can purchase a <b>memento</b> of your visit.</i>
<b>menu</b>	A list of commands or facilities displayed on screen. <i>They worked rapidly down the <b>menu</b> of reports.</i>
<b><u>minimum</u></b>	Smallest or lowest. <i>Clients with a <b>minimum</b> of 500 000 to invest.</i>
<b>occupancy</b>	An act of being a tenant or occupant. <i>Occupation of a building without a certificate of <b>occupancy</b> is illegal.</i>
<b><u>paraphernalia</u></b>	Equipment consisting of miscellaneous articles needed for a particular operation or sport etc. <i>The rituals and <b>paraphernalia</b> of government.</i>
<b>peruse</b>	Examine or consider with attention and in detail. <i>I <b>perused</b> several online reviews.</i>
<b>photograph</b>	Undergo being photographed in a certain way. <i>A <b>photograph</b> of her father.</i>
<b>promotional</b>	Relating to the publicizing of a product, organization, or venture so as to increase sales or public awareness. <i>She was on a <b>promotional</b> tour for her books.</i>
<b><u>proprietary</u></b>	(of a product) marketed under and protected by a registered trade name. <i>The company has a <b>proprietary</b> right to the property.</i>
<b>pun</b>	A humorous play on words. <i>His constant <b>punning</b> irritated her.</i>
<b><u>puzzle</u></b>	A jigsaw puzzle. <i>That s a real <b>puzzler</b>.</i>
<b>rebus</b>	A puzzle in which words are represented by combinations of pictures and individual letters; for instance, apex might be represented by a picture of an ape followed by a letter X.

<b>relic</b>	A person or thing that has survived from an earlier time but is now outmoded. <i>A museum of railway <b>relics</b>.</i>
<b>shipping</b>	Ships considered collectively, especially those in a particular area or belonging to a particular country. <i>The volume of <b>shipping</b> using these ports.</i>
<b>stuff</b>	Fill with a stuffing while cooking. <i>He knows his <b>stuff</b> and can really write.</i>
<b>thing</b>	Anything used for emphasis. <i>The <b>thing</b> I like about her is.</i>
<b>ticket</b>	Of a passenger be issued with a travel ticket. <i>The officer issued Rhodes a speeding <b>ticket</b>.</i>
<b>token</b>	Insignificantly small a matter of form only tokenish is informal. <i>A record <b>token</b>.</i>
<b>topic</b>	Some situation or event that is thought about. <i>He kept drifting off the <b>topic</b>.</i>
<b>used</b>	Having already been used. <i>After going out of his way to help his friend get the job he felt not appreciated but <b>used</b>.</i>
