Definitions of "Souvenir" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “souvenir” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Something of sentimental value.*
- *A thing that is kept as a reminder of a person, place, or event.*
- *A reminder of past events.*



Synonyms of "Souvenir" as a noun (7 Words)

keepsake	Something of sentimental value. <i>She was wearing the medal he gave her as a keepsake.</i>
memento	A reminder of past events. <i>You can purchase a memento of your visit.</i>
<u>memorial</u>	A structure erected to commemorate persons or events. <i>The Council sent a strongly worded memorial to the Chancellor of the Exchequer.</i>
<u>relic</u>	A person or thing that has survived from an earlier time but is now outmoded. <i>Miracles wrought by the relics of St Stephen.</i>
remembrance	A recognition of meritorious service. <i>A flash of remembrance passed between them.</i>
reminder	A message that helps you remember something. <i>He ignored his wife s reminders.</i>

token

A voucher that can be exchanged for goods or services, typically one given as a gift or forming part of a promotional offer.

*Ruthven was murdered and the assassin left his **token**.*



Usage Examples of "Souvenir" as a noun

- *The recording provides a souvenir of a great production.*



Associations of "Souvenir" (30 Words)

bus	Send or move around by bus. <i>The fenders had fallen off that old bus.</i>
coin	Money in the form of coins. <i>He coined the term desktop publishing.</i>
gear	A particular setting of engaged gears. <i>Murray got him some gear.</i>
item	Used to introduce each item in a list. <i>An item of clothing.</i>
keepsake	Something of sentimental value. <i>She was wearing the medal he gave her as a keepsake.</i>
kit	Young of any of various fur-bearing animals. <i>An aircraft kit.</i>

list	A formal structure analogous to a list by which items of data can be stored or processed in a definite order. <i>I listed myself for a soldier.</i>
listing	An entry in a list or register.
material	Having material or physical form or substance. <i>Material possessions.</i>
matter	A subject or situation under consideration. <i>Faecal matter.</i>
memento	A reminder of past events. <i>You can purchase a memento of your visit.</i>
menu	A list of commands or facilities displayed on screen. <i>They worked rapidly down the menu of reports.</i>
<u>minimum</u>	Smallest or lowest. <i>Clients with a minimum of 500 000 to invest.</i>
occupancy	An act of being a tenant or occupant. <i>Occupation of a building without a certificate of occupancy is illegal.</i>
<u>paraphernalia</u>	Equipment consisting of miscellaneous articles needed for a particular operation or sport etc. <i>The rituals and paraphernalia of government.</i>
peruse	Examine or consider with attention and in detail. <i>I perused several online reviews.</i>
photograph	Undergo being photographed in a certain way. <i>A photograph of her father.</i>
promotional	Relating to the publicizing of a product, organization, or venture so as to increase sales or public awareness. <i>She was on a promotional tour for her books.</i>
<u>proprietary</u>	(of a product) marketed under and protected by a registered trade name. <i>The company has a proprietary right to the property.</i>
pun	A humorous play on words. <i>His constant punning irritated her.</i>
<u>puzzle</u>	A jigsaw puzzle. <i>That s a real puzzler.</i>
rebus	A puzzle in which words are represented by combinations of pictures and individual letters; for instance, apex might be represented by a picture of an ape followed by a letter X.

relic	A person or thing that has survived from an earlier time but is now outmoded. <i>A museum of railway relics.</i>
shipping	Ships considered collectively, especially those in a particular area or belonging to a particular country. <i>The volume of shipping using these ports.</i>
stuff	Fill with a stuffing while cooking. <i>He knows his stuff and can really write.</i>
thing	Anything used for emphasis. <i>The thing I like about her is.</i>
ticket	Of a passenger be issued with a travel ticket. <i>The officer issued Rhodes a speeding ticket.</i>
token	Insignificantly small a matter of form only tokenish is informal. <i>A record token.</i>
topic	Some situation or event that is thought about. <i>He kept drifting off the topic.</i>
used	Having already been used. <i>After going out of his way to help his friend get the job he felt not appreciated but used.</i>
