Spaniel in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense

I spaniel	We spaniel
You spaniel	You spaniel
He/She/It spaniels	They spaniel

Spaniel in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I am spanielling	We are spanielling
You are spanielling	You are spanielling
He/She/It is spanielling	They are spanielling

Spaniel in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have spanielled	We have spanielled
You have spanielled	You have spanielled
He/She/It has spanielled	They have spanielled

Spaniel in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been spanielling	We have been spanielling
You have been spanielling	You have been spanielling
He/She/It has been spanielling They have been spanielling	

Spaniel in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I spanielled	We spanielled
You spanielled	You spanielled
He/She/It spanielled	They spanielled

You were spanielling	You were spanielling
He/She/It was spanielling	They were spanielling

Spaniel in Past Perfect Tense

I had spanielled	We had spanielled
You had spanielled	You had spanielled
He/She/It had spanielled	They had spanielled

Spaniel in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been spanielling	We had been spanielling
You had been spanielling	You had been spanielling
He/She/It had been spanielling	They had been spanielling

Spaniel in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will spaniel	We will spaniel
You will spaniel	You will spaniel
He/She/It will spaniel	They will spaniel

Spaniel in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be spanielling	We will be spanielling
You will be spanielling	You will be spanielling
He/She/It will be spanielling	They will be spanielling
