# **Conjugate Spanish**

#### Spanish in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>spanish</b>	We <b>spanish</b>
You <b>spanish</b>	You <b>spanish</b>
He/She/It <b>spanishes</b>	They <b>spanish</b>

#### **Spanish in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am spanishing	We are spanishing
You <b>are spanishing</b>	You <b>are spanishing</b>
He/She/It is spanishing	They are spanishing

#### **Spanish in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have spanished	We have spanished
You have spanished	You have spanished
He/She/It has spanished	They have spanished

### **Spanish in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been spanishing	We have been spanishing
You <b>have been spanishing</b>	You <b>have been spanishing</b>
He/She/It has been spanishing	They have been spanishing

#### **Spanish in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>spanished</b>	We <b>spanished</b>
You <b>spanished</b>	You <b>spanished</b>
He/She/It <b>spanished</b>	They <b>spanished</b>

#### **Spanish in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was spanishing	We were spanishing
You <b>were spanishing</b>	You <b>were spanishing</b>
He/She/It was spanishing	They were spanishing

#### **Spanish in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had spanished	We <b>had spanished</b>
You <b>had spanished</b>	You had spanished
He/She/It had spanished	They had spanished

#### **Spanish in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been spanishing	We <b>had been spanishing</b>
You <b>had been spanishing</b>	You <b>had been spanishing</b>
He/She/It had been spanishing	They had been spanishing

### **Spanish in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will spanish	We <b>will spanish</b>
You <b>will spanish</b>	You <b>will spanish</b>
He/She/It will spanish	They will spanish

## **Spanish in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be spanishing	We will be spanishing
You <b>will be spanishing</b>	You <b>will be spanishing</b>
He/She/It will be spanishing	They will be spanishing

I will have been spanishing	We will have been spanishing
