sparsely

A sparsely populated region.

**stinginess** A lack of generosity; a general unwillingness to part with money.

thrift The quality of using money and other resources carefully and not wastefully.

The values of **thrift** and self reliance.

**thriftiness** Frugality in the expenditure of money or resources.

thrifty Careful and diligent in the use of resources.

The sheep are vigorous and **thrifty**.

tightwad A mean or miserly person.

He is a notorious **tightwad**.
