## Sparingly as an Adverb

### Definitions of "Sparingly" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “sparingly” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *In a restricted or infrequent manner; in small quantities.*
- *To a meager degree or in a meager manner.*

### Synonyms of "Sparingly" as an adverb (3 Words)

**meagerly** To a meager degree or in a meager manner.  
*These voices are **meagerly** represented at the conference.*

**meagrely** To a meager degree or in a meager manner.

**slenderly** In a slim or slender manner.  
*A **slenderly** built woman.*

<b>account</b>	To give an account or representation of in words. <i>Don't do it on my <b>account</b>.</i>
<b>affordable</b>	Inexpensive; reasonably priced. <i><b>Affordable</b> homes.</i>
<b>austerity</b>	Plainness and simplicity in appearance. <i>The room was decorated with a restraint bordering on <b>austerity</b>.</i>
<b>bank</b>	Enclose with a bank. <i><b>Bank</b> roads.</i>
<b>cheap</b>	Embarrassingly stingy. <i>A <b>cheap</b> restaurant.</i>
<b>cheaply</b>	With little expenditure of money. <i>I bought this car very <b>cheaply</b>.</i>
<b>depositor</b>	A person who has deposited money in a bank or similar institution.
<b>economical</b>	Avoiding waste. <i>An <b>economical</b> shopper.</i>
<b>frugal</b>	Sparing or economical as regards money or food. <i>A <b>frugal</b> farmer.</i>
<b>frugality</b>	The quality of being economical with money or food; thriftiness. <i>He scorned the finer things in life and valued <b>frugality</b> and simplicity.</i>
<b>inexpensive</b>	Not costing a great deal; cheap. <i><b>Inexpensive</b> family restaurants.</i>
<b>meagerly</b>	To a meager degree or in a meager manner. <i>These voices are <b>meagerly</b> represented at the conference.</i>
<b>miser</b>	A stingy hoarder of money and possessions often living miserably. <i>A typical <b>miser</b> he hid his money in the house in various places.</i>
<b>paltry</b>	Not worth considering. <i>She would earn a <b>paltry</b> 33 more a month.</i>
<b>parsimony</b>	Extreme stinginess. <i>A great tradition of public design has been shattered by government <b>parsimony</b>.</i>
<b>redemptive</b>	Bringing about salvation or redemption from sin. <i><b>Redemptive</b> or redeeming love.</i>
<b>rescue</b>	Denoting or relating to a domestic animal that has been removed from a situation of abuse or neglect by a welfare organization. <i>He got out of his chair to <b>rescue</b> his cup of coffee.</i>

<b>save</b>	Save from sins. <i>Save your strength till later.</i>
<b>saving</b>	Bringing about salvation or redemption from sin. <i>Wealthy by inheritance but <b>saving</b> by constitution.</i>
<b>savings</b>	A fund of money put by as a reserve.
<b>schlock</b>	Merchandise that is shoddy or inferior. <i>Televisual <b>schlock</b>.</i>
<b>scrimp</b>	Subsist on a meager allowance. <i>Scratch and <b>scrimp</b>.</i>
<b>skimp</b>	Work hastily or carelessly; deal with inadequately and superficially. <i>She wore a yellow <b>skimp</b>.</i>
<b>sparing</b>	Moderate; economical. <i>Physicians advised <b>sparing</b> use of the ointment.</i>
<b>sparsely</b>	In a sparse manner. <i>A <b>sparsely</b> populated region.</i>
<b>stinginess</b>	A lack of generosity; a general unwillingness to part with money.
<b>thrift</b>	The quality of using money and other resources carefully and not wastefully. <i>The values of <b>thrift</b> and self reliance.</i>
<b>thriftiness</b>	Frugality in the expenditure of money or resources.
<b>thrifty</b>	Careful and diligent in the use of resources. <i>The sheep are vigorous and <b>thrifty</b>.</i>
<b>tightwad</b>	A mean or miserly person. <i>He is a notorious <b>tightwad</b>.</i>
