- allocation** The act of distributing by allotting or apportioning; distribution according to a plan.
*Unclaimed **allocations** would be held for three years.*
- allotment** The action of allotting something.
*The **allotment** of equity securities.*
- apportionment** The action or result of apportioning something.
*The **apportionment** of seats in the House of Representatives is based on the relative population of each state.*

building	The occupants of a building. <i>His hobby was the building of boats.</i>
contiguity	The sequential occurrence or proximity of stimulus and response, causing their association in the mind. <i>Nations bound together by geographical contiguity.</i>
cumulative	Increasing or increased in quantity, degree, or force by successive additions. <i>The benefits are cumulative.</i>
<u>diffusion</u>	(physics) the process in which there is movement of a substance from an area of high concentration of that substance to an area of lower concentration. <i>The rate of diffusion of a gas.</i>
<u>dimension</u>	An expression for a derived physical quantity in terms of fundamental quantities such as mass length or time raised to the appropriate power acceleration for example having the dimension of length time. <i>The final dimensions of the pond were 14 ft x 8 ft.</i>
<u>dispersion</u>	The extent to which values of a variable differ from a fixed value such as the mean. <i>The virus is transmitted in the dispersion of droplets which results from sneezing or coughing.</i>
dissemination	The property of being diffused or dispersed. <i>The dissemination of public information.</i>
distribution	An arrangement of values of a variable showing their observed or theoretical frequency of occurrence. <i>Unequal distributions of income and wealth.</i>
earmark	Identification mark on the ear of a domestic animal. <i>I will earmark this money for your research.</i>
equitable	Fair to all parties as dictated by reason and conscience. <i>An equitable distribution of gifts among the children.</i>
gap	Make an opening or gap in. <i>There are many gaps in our understanding of what happened.</i>
gill	Catch a fish in a gill net.
interval	A component of activity in interval training. <i>An interval of mourning.</i>
<u>matrix</u>	(mathematics) a rectangular array of quantities or expressions set out by rows and columns; treated as a single element and manipulated according to rules. <i>The matrix of gravel paths is hoed regularly.</i>

opening	The act of opening something. <i>There was a small opening between the trees.</i>
part	A melody or other constituent of harmony assigned to a particular voice or instrument in a musical work. <i>The friends separated after the party.</i>
percentage	An amount, such as an allowance or commission, that is a proportion of a larger sum of money. <i>I hope to be on a percentage.</i>
proportion	Give pleasant proportions to. <i>A building of vast proportions.</i>
<u>quantity</u>	The figure or symbol representing a quantity. <i>He had a quantity of ammunition.</i>
quota	(in a system of proportional representation) the minimum number of votes required to elect a candidate. <i>All the salesmen met their quota for the month.</i>
range	Range or extend over occupy a certain area. <i>A wood burning kitchen range.</i>
<u>room</u>	Share a room house or flat especially a rented one at a college or similar institution. <i>The whole room was cheering.</i>
share	Have give or receive a share of. <i>I d like to share this idea with you.</i>
space	One of two possible states of a signal in certain systems. <i>The laboratory s floor space.</i>
structure	Give a structure to. <i>He has good bone structure.</i>
<u>widening</u>	The act of making something wider.
